As the film's trailer suggests, "we are all children of the age of plastic." Plastic is found almost everywhere - in domestic settings, in the oceans and deserts, and even in our blood! The amount of plastic humankind has produced since the beginning of the plastic era is enough to circle our globe six times with plastic Clingfilm. Director Werner Boote, the grandchild of a plastics industry pioneer, travels the world documenting the impact of plastic products on human lives and diverse environments.
