A newly self-proclaimed environmentalist who could no longer avoid pointing the finger at himself, Colin Beavan decided to leave behind his liberal complacency with a vow to make as little environmental impact as possible for one year. No more automated transportation, no more electricity, no more non-local food, no more material consumption...no problem. That is, until his espresso-guzzling, retail-worshipping wife Michelle and their two-year-old daughter are dragged into the fray. This film provides a front row seat into the experiment that became a media sensation as well as an intriguing inside look at familial relationships, the strains and bonds that result from the family's struggle with their radical lifestyle change.
