In this issue of *Earth First! Journal* Karen Picket reports on the tragic incident during the protests against logging in the Headwaters forest, and several pages are dedicated to David "Gypsy" Chain's memorial. In addition, Josh Laughlin contributes an interview with prominent redwood activist Julia Butterfly, and George Monbiot discusses how to exploit the media.

Just after noon on Thursday, September 17, Headwaters forest defender David Nathan Chain, known to his friends as "Gypsy," lost his life when a tree cut by a Pacific Lumber (PL) logger crushed him to death. [...] The fact that the loggers were indeed aware of the protesters' presence was corroborated by a videotape recorded less than an hour before Chain was killed. It contains threats and admonitions by the logger to "Get the fuck out of here or there's going to be a tree coming your way!"
