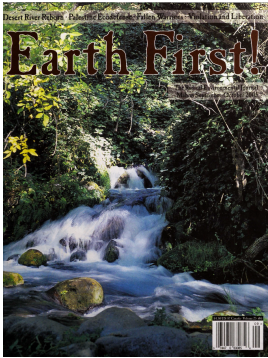

It would also grant the editorial collective a level of authority that is incompatible with an egalitarian movement.
