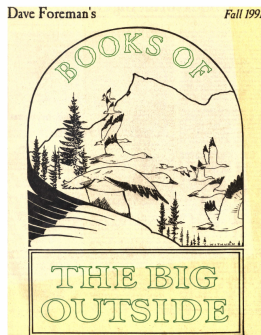

This catalog lists books, music, poetry and other material produced by individuals “who are able to eloquently articulate the wisdom from the wild, or to draw profound lessons from human history and that are in harmony with that wisdom.”
