Maybe we're overestimating how bad things really are. In the absence of any kind of real movement, we compromise what we know in our hearts, and funnel our energy into the system. We wonder if we weren't so aware of the evils, if life would be easier.

Yet we must not despair nor become paralyzed by our legitimate cynicism. What is the value of humanity and what self-worth can we find if we can not effectively resist ecocide? Yes, it is a difficult path; we are trying to be feral in a managed world. We must travel our lives as free, joyful human beings and we must strive to seek our place in the natural balance of things. Do anything less, and we will not have the material with which to build a new society upon the ashes of the old. This means that those of us who really care about the future must find creative ways to circumvent these dead ends. Never underestimate your own inner power! Look how far you've come from the school kid who loved T.V. to the being who understands what freedom means, and fights for it in everyday life.

So where do we start? There are so many issues, causes, projects. Sure, we can concern ourselves with the destruction of tropical rainforests and support faraway resistance struggles, but we can not cop out. You stand on stolen, occupied and devastated land. Global destruction starts in our own backyard and is forcibly exported throughout the world, as our consumer society is shoved down people's throats through a variety of military, political and economic methods. We in the industrialized world have a special task (or joy) - to impair the dominant culture's ability to expand, and ultimately to function. There are many creative ways we can achieve this (some of which you will find within these pages), and we start by removing the dominant paradigm from our minds and by learning to see in new ways. It's kind of like cleaning your room - it's a constant process, and you have to sweep away the dust often. This project calls for rejecting the whole of modern civilization and building a life-centered culture, where all life and future generations have equal rights and claims to a healthy natural environment. A return to a simple, joyful life of self-sufficiency. This necessitates acquiring and passing on those skills and attitudes that allow us to inhabit a place in a sacred and sustainable manner. There is much we can learn from the indigenous and aboriginal cultures which remain, if we are willing to listen. Introduce yourself and your friends to the wildness of the earth and of that within. Move away from materialism, apathy and easy reform. Band together with fellow resisters and practice living together as a tribe. Begin a wheatpasting/billboard alteration/sabotage conspiracy. Stay in one place for a while, for a long time, and get to really know and love it. Learn how to take care of each other, physically and emotionally. Learn your local plants, eat more wild foods! Buy little, share more, work less. Start a fire, dismantle or disable a machine of destruction. Pick a local eco-raper and hunt them: hinder their ability to continue their operations. Spread your subversive creativity and passion!

Remember. Learn from history and herstory. We are at war with the systems and functions of industrialized society; the economy, the accumulation of resources, the exploitation, the technology, the values and arrogant assumptions. We do not to sieze control of, but rather to destroy tirely, the means of production. We do not seek a program or leader to follow. We seek an end to governments, the act of governing, and the power over other living beings. A caution: we must be careful not to aim for some nihilistic glorification of the eco-warrior role. There is a screaming need to re-learn where and who we are on this planet, to understand the meaning of harmony, to transcend our domestication. Haste, bold ones, the wolf howls and the owl hoots; let not their crying ghosts haunt our pitiful monuments.

U.S. Under Attack By Internal Enemies I-80 Grinds to Halt as Crazed **Bicyclists Occupy Freeway**



BERKELEY CRITICAL MASSERS SHUT DOWN THE INTERSTATE :

About 100 blevelists took part in a 12-mile rampage through the streets of Berkeley yesterday, in a dangerous challenge to prevailing notions of public space.

The "Critical Mass Bike-Ride," a bicycle protest that takes over the East Bay on the second Friday of each month. grew wild and out of control as the bicyclists confronted motorists and frustrated police attempts to protect the status quo. At one point, the bicyclists stopped traffic on I-80, taking over every lane as traffic slowed to its usual rush hour crawl.

But despite the disruptive character of the ride, there was relatively little violence. The only reported complaint came from an angry C.E.O., who claims bicyclists stole his cordless car phone and made several long distance phone calls before returning it. Other motor

ists expressed admiration for the bravery of the protesters, and expressed regret that their commute was so lackluster and dull by comparison.

The Police, however, are not so amused. All participants were promptly arrested and punished to the full extent of the law, with charges ranging from "disrupting the flow of workers" to "inciting to wreak havoc."

Police say this decentralized but highly disciplined cadre of two-wheeled radicals are difficult to combat, since they have no leaders nor any specific program. Rather, the bike protest appears to be a spontaneous response to absurd and intolerable social conditions, and is therefore extremely unpredictable

"We have no way of knowing what they'll do next," said Police Officer R. Lopes. "Even our undercover infiltra-

Insurgency Will Only Spread, **Experts Warn**

The attack on law, order, and gen eral decency characterized by yesterday's mischievous bike ride will only continue to spread, say experts on social disorder. What's more, these momentary disturbances of the status quo have been a constant problem for the government

since this nation was founded in 1776. According to Willie Wonk, a fellow at the Institute for the Corporate Analysis of Social Change (ICASC), disobedience is a permanent part of the landscape of civilized culture. "Anyone trying to understand our epoch has to come to grips with the existence of these small but persistent groups of freethinking individuals...who don't take orders without flinching.

These groups, says Wonk, become a sort of "internal enemy," hacking away at the shared values that make government in a democracy possible. If uncontained by a healthy dose of state violence and/or propaganda, such dissident movements can have an enormous effect, sometimes inflicting more damage than even the most powerful enemy state

The ICASC has studied this issue in depth and has concluded that what is dangerous about these movements is their infectiousness. "Because these activities inspire a form of camaraderie and fun at its most vulgar and subversive level." Wonk says "they tend to expand, giving rise to even more effec-

People's Park caper a mystery

The men drove around the park at a high rate of speed before plowing


> into the wood railings surrounding the volleyball courts on the east side of the park, Foley said

Five people apparently watching the incident in the park ran away with them, Foley said.

Cars create untold waste Car and road construction requires the extraction, processing and transport of huge amounts of metals, plastics, acids, glass and rubber. Each process creates its own environmental hazards and wastes vast amounts of land, energy and labour.

The car uses more than a third of the world's oil and plastics. Oil extraction and transportation is responsible for devastating pollution, the destruction of unique ecosystems and has major cause of several wars.

Road accidents killed more than 5000 people in Britain last year, while there where a quarter of a million reported injuries. Non-human casualties have never been counted.

Car Wars Polarize the Swiss

Zurich - Pollution from cars first led to protests during the late 1970s when Swiss activists blocked streets to demand a reduction in vehicular traffic. Since then, there have been many demonstrations against cars, as well as attempts to ban the dirtiest cars, introduce catalytic converters, close streets, reduce speeds and improve public transit. But this has not been sufficient.

In Zürich, anti-car groups have slashed tires, smashed windshields, scratched car bodies and firebombed car showrooms. Almost every week such incidents of sabotage are reported. Stickers showing a burning car and the slogan "CARS HAVE NO FUTURE" have appeared. In Geneva in 1988, when smog became particularly serious, squads of angry demonstrators pulled drivers from their vehicles, gave them bus tickets and led them away.

The increasing rejection of cars has caused. a unique phenomenon in Swiss politics: the creation of a "Swiss Car Party" dedicated to

> defending vehicular traffic. This three-yearold party has gained one seat in the national parliament and received up to five percent of the vote in cities and cantons (counties). It is one of the most successful parties of the last few years, matched only by the Greens. The platform of the Car Party is right wing and its rhetoric is fascist. Its president, Mr. Dreher, once proposed putting all car haters against a wall and torching them with flame throwers. The traditional right wing parties are a bit embarrassed, chiefly because the Car Party has led to a radicalization of the right. The right is also chagrined because the Car Party lays bare the capitalist organization of life — i.e., that without the car, the system must collapse.

Since the car has become politicized, no one can simply park, drive or wash one as before. You become politically active just by doing so. The car is an ideal enemy: it is everywhere and it is vulnerable.



To catch a thief: Employee stealing is on the rise

In less than a year, Brenda Corrett, 26, sold and created bogus advertising worth about \$25,000.

She would offer "free" advertising to companies, then claim she had sold the ads and collect a commission, or would accept pay-ments from other customers for

bogus ads.

Eventually, Cornett could no longer hide her activities, and her employer, Paddock Publishing of Lexington, Ky., pressed charges.

Cornett pleaded guilty to felony theft and forgery in March. She's now serving a two-year sentence at the Kentucky Correctional Institute for Women. tutefor Women.

Her employer's actions were unusual. Although employees steal

from businesses — more than \$200 million nationwide each day, by one estimate — few employee thefts are prosecuted.

Besides forcing Cornett to accept responsibility for her actions, Paddock Publishing owner Jerry Kuykendall sent a clear message to be selff. "Appears stealing will be his staff: "Anyone stealing will be fired and they will be prosecuted,"

Employee theft ranges from pilfering, such as taking company supplies or eating supermarket food without paying for it, to embezzlign millions in cash.

piles such data, so no actual numbers are available. His estimate is based on earlier surveys by the U.S. Department of Commerce and the American Man-agement Association that he updated based on increases in crime and in the Consumer Price Index.

Still, security experts said employee pilfering is on the rise. They blame the increase on worker addictions to drugs, alcohol and gambling. They also point to personal greed and a slumping economy as factors. sonal greed army as factors.

Companies worried about their bottom line in a stalled economy are showing more concern about

losses and less tolerance for thieves, said Robert Barry, chief executive officer of the National Loss Prevention Bureau, a private New York company that checks on prospective employees for busi-nesses. The bureau compiles databases of people who were fired for stealing or other crimes and passes that information to businesses who subscribe to its service.

Generally, when a company catches an employee stealing, the worker is fired immediately, Barry said. Although companies are quick to fire a thief, they aren't so

quick to fire a trier, they aren't so eager to prosecute. Retailers, particularly, often don't file charges against an em-bezzler or thief because they fear it will tarnish their public image,

said Jeff Jacob, security director for Central Bank & Trust Co. of Lexington, who has 15 years' ex-perience in retail security.

Department stores and other retailers have a persistent problem with employee theft because workers have more opportunity to steal and the merchandise is attractive. Jacob said.

Merchants often hire young clerks at low wages for temporary positions and assign them to cover several departments, he said.

Clerks steal in a variety of ways. They claim fake returns of merchandise, ring up "no sales" and pocket the cash, or hide merchandise in trash baskets and retrieve it later.

Losses in the retail industry

alone amount to more than \$20 billion a year, mostly from employ-ee theft, said Martin Lefkowitz, director of special projects for the U.S. Chamber of Commerce.



I also wrote fake letters to and from different departments at DLI, on official letterhead. Always, the signature on the letter was a takeoff on an administrator's name. Copies of these letters often ended up in the in-boxes of the people I was satirizing. I was never caught, or even suspected. But when I was preparing to quit, I was forced to "break" my computer's hard drive and reinitialize it from scratch, to avoid prying eyes finding my "deleted" writing files.

From inside DLI, I investigated personnel/financial abuses by the higher-ups. I groomed moles and deep throats all over the post, who provided me with a steady stream of juicy information and even blatant gossip, which I repeated in broadsheets and pamphlets typed up on the office computer and copied at office expense. These sources provide information to this day.

segmented, regimented, measured. Each sterile, precise, mechanical unit of time becomes equal to another, erasing the subversive, natural unraveling of events, and their ability to proceed in fits and spurts, crawl along, or sometimes even stop altogether. And thus are the natural rhythms of life squeezed out of your day.

With your use of a computer, you have similarly shackled yourself to the more-fastereasier paradigm and its erroneous assumptions that proliferation of data is the same as information, and that the ability to process this data quickly is the same as wisdom. Technologies that are supposedly designed to improve communication (TV, computers, faxes, e-mail) speed up the flow of data without giving us any insight into how to coordinate, use, or attach meaning to it. The element that is missing is the muman connection, direct experience, the full use of all our senses. Out of context of our lives, and without participation of our senses, our sweat, our emotions, your eco-net transmissions don't add up to yuppie dung. In other words, if i can't smell it, taste it, feel it, hear it and see it, i don't want to be part of your "information revolution".

People have come to believe that the data itself is meaningful, when in fact it is merely signal or image sending. This is true whether you are downloading stock share prices or news of the latest squatter riots in Berlin. True learning is a slow process of integrating new information with old knowledge toward a clear goal. That requires not technologic but human control. We are now bombarded with data; data is out of control. Lack of personal control over data results in anxiety, a sense of meaninglessness, true ignorance, severe misunderstanding, the inability to solve simple problems, and a general feeling of being overwhelmed. In other words, psychosis, which adequately describes the mental state of a large portion of the planet's human inhabitants. A prime example is putting a sticker on your four-wheeled pollution machine saying "save the planet".

In our search for "information" and "awareness" our machines are getting in the way of what is around us. Just as driving a car causes us to become out of touch with and fatally misunderstand the terrain we move over, so do computers warp our ways of understanding and relating to the world. Thus you have the bizarre human behavior of sitting at a computer and reading on eco-met about the destruction of tropical rainforests, and being "concerned" about a forest whose trees you have never walked among. Meanwhile the local forest within walking distance is being bulldozed for condos. The Forest Service uses computer models of forests because it enables them to better manage and exploit trees for lumber (and to falsify data about how many trees are actually left), as trees become board feet - more meaningless, passionless data. Forest supervisors are able to meet their quotas and "get out the cut" without feeling or seeing the pain of the forest. Activists get sucked into this game, and feel they need to counter with their own data about how many board feet can be sustainably cut, and become just as guilty of accepting this sick twisted view of trees as board feet. Their view of the trees they are trying to save has become altered by the technology they are using. Here is the real battlefield, the "final frontier" of industrial progress; your mind and the way in which you view the world, Will you move on to replace your computer with "interactive programming" when your techno-masters tell you that computers are obsolete? You are not willing to accept their values, yet you embrace their technology? Don't be fooled, the two cannot be separated. Their values are inherent in their technology.


Many people will argue that technology is neutral, that any technology is merely a benign instrument, a tool, and, depending upon the hands into which it falls, it may be used one way or another. There is nothing that prevents a technology from being used well or badly, nothing intrinsic in the technology itself that can predetermine its use, its control or its effects upon individual lives or political forms. Television or computers are merely windows or conduits, the argument goes, through which any perception or reality may pass. They therefore have the potential to be enlightening to people who use them and are potentially useful to democratic processes. These assumptions are wrong.































Why we want you to smash your computer





Ignore, for the moment, the fact that your computer was produced by a woman or child laborer in a third-world country under slave-like working conditions; at a wage of pennies on the hour, for up to 12 hours a day, and in constant exposure to toxic fumes and acids.

Ignore also (if you can) the fact that the toxic effluent resulting from the manufacture of your computer is poisoning wildlife and irreparably damaging ecosystems.

Try to ignore the fact that your computer is plugged into a power grid that recuires the damming, diversion and flooding of rivers and waterways, resulting in the destruction of riparian habitat and the interruption of fish spawning runs.

Try not to remember the money (probably in the thousands of dollars) that you gave to some nice company like IBM or Hewlitt-Packard, who are at this moment spending it on the development of government and corporate data banks, surveillance systems, and computer guidance systems for missiles, atomic bombs, belicopter gunships and tanks, all for use in the empire's latest wars.

But never mind all those nasty little moral issues, try to remember instead why you got a computer in the first place. Because it "saves time" in putting out your 'zine or newspaper; maybe it allows you to monitor the data on forests and clearcutting; through it you are linked to a network of activists and information from around the world, and can get information on your "cause" out fast; or because you know that governments and corporations have this technology, and if "we" don't use it. "they" will control the flow of information.

Ah, yes. You Timothy Leary, cyher-punk, virtual reality, techno-weenie hacker, computer "activists" (what's so active about sitting in front of a glowing screen?). Ask yourself this question. Is there any important human-scale, human-oriented occupation or activity that is restricted by the abscence of computers? Of course not. Well, then where did this need for humans to "save time" come from? We never thought we had a problem with slow technique until the computer industry told us that we did. As Thoreau and other critics of industrialism pointed out in the 19th century, we "save time" by killing eternity.

The Chicago anarchists of a century ago, who produced a weekly paper, depended on a mass movement to provide enough able hands to publish frequently. Now, one anarchist publisher told us, if it wasn't for computers, his paper wouldn't exist since so few people work on the project. The same is true for many single-person 'zines. It is dehatable whether this is an argument for computers or a statement about the weakness of a movement. That machines are the proper response to a movement's malaise brings to mind John Locke's prescient statement, "There is no such thing as a labor saving device." However, his idea usually needs explanation since his statement does not appear to be accurate on the face of it. For instance, it seems obvious that one can dig a ditch faster with a mechanized back hoe than with a hand shovel.

However, that equation is based on the social assumptions of technology which always neglect the totality of aggregate labor needed to excavate with a machine. Perhaps a better example would be the sewing machine, which unquestionably is faster to sew with than hand stitching. Yet, when considering every aspect of production - mining, drilling, manufacturing assembling, transportation, sales points, repairs, disposal - the whole world-wide technological grid needed to bring such a machine to market (and then have machine sewing arise as a labor-intensive industry) - a massive amount more total social time is spent in sewing than when it was done by hand.

Similarly with computers. Whereas some tasks may be reduced in time expended by certain individuals and job categories (almost exclusively in society's upper echelons), in general computers link up increasingly more people into a dependency on the world-wide industrial grid for activity which was previously accomplished with paper and pencil. Again, aggregate labor has increased, not decreased.

Also, no work day has been shortened, and no worker's pay has been raised due to increased efficiency. In fact, computers provide over the acceleration of work, as more is expected in a shorter amount of time from workers who have their outputs monitored by bosses demanding increased production from these new miraculous machines and their human appendages. Workers are experiencing more stress, physical injury, pay reductions, and a further deskilling of work as well as its accelerated pace.





Consider this. The wonderful communications technology which you rave on about for its ability to connect you to all parts and peoples of the world has an unforgivable price tag attached to it. Technological development necessarily bulldozes diversity and creates deepening dependencies on the industrialized monoculture. Television and computers are the ideal tools for dissemination of the ideas and values of the dominant culture, as it brings non-industrialized societies around to the Western way of thinking. "Learning more about other cultures" through these technologies is bullshit, because the values and ideas of oral tradition and connection to the land cannot be communicated as data or image.

So when did you decide that you "needed" a personal computer, and what kind of empowerment has it given you? "They" already have control. The personal computer you have in front of you represents only a sidebar market, an opportunity for the computer industry to make a little extra money. They have created a "need" which was not there before. The sick aspect is how many revolutionaries fell into this "needing" like eager little consumers. The architects of industrial society are in a constant battle to redefine the world and our relation to it as humans, in order to effectively maximize their profits and control. In the computer, they have found the perfect tool for managing the world and controlling people's perceptions of it.

I don't need to tell you this, but aside from the use of sheer, brutal force, one of the main ways in which the dominant culture keeps its hold on power is through collective belief. As long as people believe, or continue to act as if they believe, in the myths of industrialized society, these myths continue to prevail as truth. For example, the industrial-age myth of telling time. If you affix a time manacle (more benignly referred to as a watch) to your wrist and show up to work when it tells you it is 8:00 AM, then you have shackled yourself (however involuntarily or coerced) to the industrial notion of time;

Attack on Deadheads is no hallucination

idizine 60's Rock Star on FBI Payroll

WASHINGTON, Oct. 17 The singer of one of the most successful and notorious rock and roll bands of the 1960's love generation was employed by the Federal Bureau of Investigation since 1968, according to recently released documents obtained through a 1985 lawsuit under the Freedom of

Information Act.

Jerome Garcia, a guitarist and lead singer for The Grateful Dead, a rock band with a large and loyal following among the hippie and drug counterculture of the 1960's and 70's, was employed by the FBI from 1968 to 1975 as part of the federal agency's Counter-Intelligence Program (COINTELPRO). COINTELPRO was designed to infiltrate and gather intelligence on violent and revolutionary groups inside the U.S.

According to an FBI document dated According to an FBI document dated November 1968, the agency was concerned with the "merger of violent leftist groups with elements of the hippie and drug culture, notably the YIPPIES and rock groups such as MC5." To counteract the possible use of large crowds of rock concert fans to foment civil disturbances during the Vietnam War, the FBI employed Garcia to "channel youth dissent and rebellion into more benign and non-threatening directions." directions."

The documents, which were the subject of a five year lawsuit by a group of Grateful Dead fans called Deadheads for Freedom of Information and the American Civil Liberties Union, were withheld by the FBI as classified material for reasons of national security.

A Federal Judge ordered the documents released in July of 1990, and they were finally declassified and made public in October of this year. It is un-known how much money was involved or whether Mr. Garcia remain am-ployed by the FBI, since large portions of many documents were deleted and the release of others is still an issue of kgal contention.



FBI spokesman Dick Held said that the COINTELPRO program was discontinued in 1975 and that Mr. Garcia no longer works for the agency, as his situation was "unique to the 60's."

One of the original plaintiffs in the 1985 lawsuit was Brent Mydland, the keyboardist for the Grateful Dead who died of a drug overdose in August of 1990. According to Nancy Morehouse of Deadheads for Freedom of Information, the lawsuit was prompted by rumors of the band's fan mailing list being sent to the Drug Enforcement Agency for surveillance of drug dealers and users, and of fan mail being opened and forwarded to the FBI.

Grateful Dead concerts are notorious for illegal drug use among fans, specifically hallucinogenics such as LSD, psyllocybin mushrooms and MDA. Morehouse said that "at first I couldn't believe that Jerry would be involved in something like this, I mean, it's not like he needs the money - at \$30 per ticket he makes millions that's a lie!"

Grateful Dead fans interviewed at a recent concert in Eugene, Oregon expressed similar feelings of disbelief, shock and anger.

Morehouse said that Mr. Mydland was the "only one of the band who really seemed interested in finding out if these rumors were true" and speculated that Mr. Garcia's rumored involvement with heroin may have landed him in trouble with federal law enforcement agencies, who then pressured him to work as part of COINTELPRO to avoid

prosecution.

Mr. Held said that he was not at liberty to discuss the FBI's recruitment policies or to speculate upon Mr. Garcia's drug use. Mr. Garcia was unavailable for comment, but a band spokesperson asked about the released documents said "No way man, like,






ccept the principle of an army - a collection of military technologies and people to run them - all gathered together for the purpose of fighting, overpowering, killing, and winning, then it is obvious that the supervisors of armies will be the sort of people who desire to fight, overpower, kill and win and who are also good at these assignments; generals. The fact of generals then, is predictable by the creation of armies The kinds of generals are also predetermined. Humanistic, pacifistic, loving generals are extremely rare. It is useless to advocate that we have more of them.

If you accept the existence of automobiles, you also accept the existence of roads laid upon the landscape, oil to run the cars and huge institutions to find the oil, pump it and distribute it, as well as continued wars to ensure the huge institutions' access to the oil. In addition you accept a speederup lifestyle and movement through the terrain at speeds that make it impossible to pay attention to whatever is growing there. Humans who use cars sit in fixed positions for long hours following a narrow strip of gray pavement, with eyes fixed forward, engaged in the task of driving. Slowly they evolve into carpeople. McLuhan told us that cars extended the human feet, but he put it the wrong way. They replaced them.

If you accept nuclear power plants, you also accept a techno-scientific-industrialmilitary elite. Without these people in charge, you could not have nuclear power. You and i setting together with a few friends could not build such a plant, nor could we handle or store the radioactive waste products that remain dangerous to life for thousands of years. The wastes, in turn, determine that future societies will have to maintain a technological capacity to deal with the problem and the military capability to protect the wastes. In all of these instances, the basic form of the technology determines the way it will be used, who will use it was to what ends.

And so it is with television and computers. Far from being "neutral", they are a narrow shannel through which much perception and information may not pass. Dozens of technical limitations define the boundaries of these mediums' content. Some information can be conveyed totally, some in only a very distorted way; but most knowledge useful to human understanding of the complexities of existence cannot be conveved. Not accidentally, the kinds and forms of information that can pass through fit the interests of the handful of corporations that dominate TV and computers. For them, these technologies are instruments of psychic colonization, funneling human awareness into a hard-edged reality based upon saleable products. That TV and computers serve that reality was obvious to those corporations soon after their invention.



Terrorists take more swipes at Americans, U.S. interests

VIRGINIA BEACH, Va. — Toxins funneled through air conditioning yents? Nuclear materials detonated on a city street? A missile fired at an airport?

It used to be the stuff of science fiction and thriller novels. No more, say American and international terrorism experts who gathered here last week at the Pentagon's request to map the future of terrorism.

Their conclusion: Prospects for terrorist attacks are ever-expanding and increasingly chilling.

The U.S. government, worried that it lacks a long-term strategy to deal with catastrophic attacks at home and abroad, has undertaken an ambitious project to drine the future of terrorism until 2010. Who will carry out attacks, how, when and where, and against whom?

"We need to know the array of things that can slam dunk us, even those eventualities that appear a remote threat but could have devastating impact," said Air Force Col E. Douglas Menarchik, terrorism policy director at the Department of Defense.

The girm future predicted by terrorism experts stands in contrast

U.S. interests even if not conducted against Americans, said Peter Probet, a Pentagon specialist on terrorism. For example, if the growing lalamic terror in Egpt succeeds in unseating pro-Western President Hosail Mubarak, he said, the United States could find itself confronted with an unfriendly government in x country nivocal to its interests in the

with an unfriendly government in a country pivotal to its interests in the old-tich Middle East.

Its self-declared status as the world's sole remaining superpower could make the United States even more vulnerable.

"The United States is a target of latest and amplify for name sechies."

The United ocases as a suger in hatred and enmity for many people, around the world," said Alberto Coll, deputy assistant secretary of defense for special operations and low-intensity conflict.

In fact, despite the drop in in national attacks, Americans tinue to account for about percent of the targets, according the State Department report.

The unrest in Europe, a result of powerful nationalist forces and massive immigration flows, is of great concern to terrorism specialists who note that it was a single assassin's bullet in a destabilized Europe that launched World War I in 1914.

Computers play an enormous role as a commodity within the world economy, but their larger purpose, according to computer pioneer Joseph Weizenbaum, was to "conserve America's social and political institutions. It (the computer) butressed them and immunized them ..." Capital's world empire, following World War II, had developed to such a degree of complexity that it could no longer administer and coordinate its apparatus without the introduction of methods appropriate to its size, geography and structure. The stock market, the board room, and the Pentagon war room could not function without the sophisticated technology of computerization. Computers are the ideal technology of imperial domination witness the new computer weapons of the Gulf War. Computers are ideal for keeping track of "resources" to be exploited, whether they are trees or workers. They are also ideal for surveillence and control, from the intelligence files of the CIA to the FBI to your local police. The inherently centralized nature of the technology is anti-community, anti-democratic, and makes its use as a tool in fact harmful to any meaningful revolution. An entire world of human beings is being redesigned and unified to fit in with the passive, atomic, commodity-based economy, the civilization of freeways, skyscrapers, suburbs and supermarkets that is today's dominant form of social organization. The technologies that mediate the information we recieve do just that - they mediate and separate us from direct experience. It is this separation that is the dangerous and destructive aspect of the technologies we so easily accept into our lives. The ideology of separation is inherent in the medium, no matter how "revolutionary" the project it is applied to.

In no way can computers be a part of a truly revolutionary project, since they are designed not for communicating knowledge and understanding, but rather for the efficient storage, retrieval and manipulation of data. A society, or a social movement, whose values, decisions, and courses of action are based solely on electronic representation is totalitarian. We must return to the "outdated" methods of spoken and written language, oral tradition, and direct experience. No "virtual reality" for me, thanks.

At the dawn of the machine age, people knew that the new devices being forced upon them would fundamentally alter their lives in a way they did not want and fought back against the use of power looms, the factoriums, and the work discipline which was demanded by them This resistance to industrialization and mechanization has often been superficially criticized a being only a reaction to the job loss which was entailed in the shift from small craft shop to the new factories. But those involved sensed (quite correctly) that a new, much less human world was evolving, one which would destroy what decent aspects were left of an earlier age. In England, artisans and mechanics, peasants and craftsmen, smashed machines, burned factories, and assassinated mill owners.

This late 18th/early 19th century movement of British machine-breakers, the Luddites, ras so successful in mobilizing the population against industrialism, that the destruction of equipment was declared a capital offense and often a dozen men were hung at once for the "crime". In Lancastershire, power loom woolen production could only commence with the stationing of 20,000 British troops in the district. Contrary to the predictions of a glowing new era which the machines would herald, the opponents of the new system were right. Industrialism ushered in an era of unmitigated misery for people and a destruction of the environment, an era which continues unabated throughout the world today.

Where are the exceptions that technology enthusiasts can show? Which radical doubts that technology and industrialism must be centrally administered and requires a worldwide material and political grid to produce their splendors? Where is the utopian who has a vision of steel and concrete, plastic and computer chips, which does not require a robotized working class toiling at extraction and manufacturing, and whose effluent does not poison the earth and its inhabitants? Show me the non-polluting, convivial, democratic. peaceful model in which industrialism and technology could exist after a revolution. i don't think it can be done.

So pass me the three-pound sledge and kindly step away from that computer console. It's time for the new Luddism.

ASHLAND — A radical environ-mental group took credit Friday for recent vandalism to an Ashland Exxon station and claimed also to have damaged four highway signs for McDonald's, Exxon and Shell ASHLAND - A radical

Oregon State Police said they Oregon State Folice and they had received no complaints of van-dalism to signs Thursday night or Friday morning. No damage to signs was evident on a drive along Interstate 5 from the Mt. Ashland ccess road to Talent.

saccess road to Talent.

State Highway Division sign supervisor Henry Monter said be patrolled the area between the Siskiyou Summit and Talent Friday and discovered no damage.

However, he said a highway sign in the northbound lane at Ashland's south interchange had been vandalized Sept. 7 and Oct. 6. The sign, which bore a gas station logo, had been painted over with the words, "Boycott Earth Rape."

At \$11 per square foot, Montez estimated the 10-by-14 sign cost


The group said drastic measures were needed because "through leg-islative means the atrocities of these companies."


Guthmiller said the authors of the statement had to have some connection to vandalism at his station because it was not reported in local papers. He said vandalism to independently owned businesses was misguided because it would





Vandals, using a heavy-duty hacksaw, cut the support wires holding a 50-foot pole Sunday evening, disrupting electricity to about 200 businesses and residences in north Eugene.

Police said they were weighing the possibility that the incident might be linked to three firebombings of federal facilities in January and the disabling of a fourth


explosive device discovered April 5 outside the entrance to the U.S. Army's Southern Oregon recruiting headquarters in west

The earlier firebombings, which coincided with the outbreak of hostilities in the Persian Gulf, caused extensive damage to facilities owned by the Internal Revenue Service, the Marines and the Army.


An anonymous call placed to a reporter Sunday claimed that downing the pole was intended to keep a television special honoring American troops from appearing on a Eugene television station.

"Are we looking at a connection? Certainly we are," said Eugene police Sgt. Chuck Tilby, who is heading the department's probe of the firebombing incidents. "We would be remiss if we didn't."

In deciphering the meaning of this pattern of response to the Panthers, Weatherman and others during the past twenty years who have attempted to go beyond more symbolic pro-test of, say, genocide, it is important to look behind the cliches customarily used to explain the American pacifist posture (however revealing these may be in themselves). More to the point than concerns that groups such as the Panthers "bring this [violent repression] on themselves" the sentiment voiced by a prominent Illinois anti-draft organizer during the winter of 1969-70:

This idea of armed struggle or armed self-defense the Black Panther Party, the Weatherman and a few other groups is a very bad scene, a really danger-ous thing for all of us. This isn't Algeria or Vietnam, it's the United States . . these tactics are not only counterproductive in that they alienate people who are otherwise very sympathetic to us . . . and lead to the sort of thing which just happened in Chicago

but they run the very real risk of bringing the same sort of violent repression down on all of us (emphasis added).

Precisely. The preoccupation with avoiding actions which ight "provoke violence" is thus not borne on a sincere pelief that violence will, or even can truly be avoided. Pacifists, no less than their unpacifistic counterparts, are quite aware that violence already exists as an integral aspect of the execution of state policies and requires no provocation; this is a formative basis of their doctrine. What is at issue then cannot be a valid attempt to stave off, or even minimize violence per se. Instead, it can only be a conscious fort not to refocus state violence in such a way that it would directly impact American pacifists themselves. This is true ven when it can be shown that the tactics which could rigger such a refocusing might in themselves alleviate a real measure of the much more massive state-inflicted violence occurring elsewhere; better that another hundred thousand Indochinese peasants perish under a hail of cluster bombs and napalm than that America's principled progressives suffer real physical pain while rendering their government's

Viewed in this light, a great many things make sense. For instance, the persistent use of the term "responsible leadin describing the normative nonviolent sector of American dissent - always somewhat mysterious when applied to supposed radicals (or German Jews) — is clarified as signifying nothing substantially different from the accomodation of the status quo it implies in more conventional settings. The "rules of the game" have long since been established and tacitly agreed to by both sides of the osten-sible "oppositional equation:" demonstrations of "resistence" to state policies will be allowed so long as they do nothing to materially interfere with the implementation of those policies. The responsibility of the oppositional leadership in such a trade-off is to insure that state processes are not threatened by substantial physical disruption; the reciprocal responsibility of the government is to guarantee the general safety of those who play according to the rules. This comfortable scenario is enhanced by the mutual under-standing that certain levels of "appropriate" (symbolic) protest of given policies will result in the "oppositional victory" of their modification (ie: really a "tuning" of policy by which it may be rendered more functional and efficient; never an abandonment of funamental policy thrusts) while efforts to move beyond this metaphorical medium of dissent will be "by any means necessary" and by all parties concerned. Meanwhile, the entire unspoken arrangement is covered by a layer of stridently abusive rhetoric directed by

each side against the other.

We are left with a husk of opposition, a ritual form capable of affording a sentimentalistic "I'm OK, you're OK" satisfaction to its subscribers at a psychic level, but utterly useless in terms of transforming the power relations engender ing perpetuation of systemic global violence. Such a defect can, however, be readily sublimated within the aggregate comfort zone produced by the continuation of American business as usual; those who remain within the parameters of nondisruptive dissent allowed by the state, their symbolic duty to the victims of US policy done (and with the bases of state power wholly unchallenged), can devote themselves to the prefiguration of the revolutionary future society with which they proclaim they will replace the present social order (having, no doubt, persuaded the state to overthrow itself through the moral force of their arguments).

Milwaukee Stunned by Threat Of Warfare for Black Equality

Milwaukee

A Milwaukee alderman has stunned and divided this quiet, no-nonsense city with his efforts to build a black millitia that he says will take violent action if his inds for racial parity are not set within five years.

The alderman, Michael McGee, former Black Panther who repsents one of the city's poorest, ont crime-ridden districts, says the inner city has watched as the rest of Mills Waukee has prospered.

prospered. He has vowed to promote vio-ence unless the city creates a \$100 aillion jobs program and takes ther steps to revive black neigh-

"We've done things the nonvio-lent way, and it hasn't gotten us anywhere," McGee said in an inter-view. "The only way to get respect is to be willing to use violence. We either stand ther® with our backs to the wall or fight our way out."

Some White Outrage

Many white Milwaukee resients have responded in outrage one white alderman called icGee's demands a "clear-cut case of extortion." Mayor John O. No. uist, who is white and a one-tip ally of McGee, has called for his resignation, saying, "In this busi-ness, you have to decide: You're in the system or you're out of it."

They cheered and hooted and od in ovation as McGee, dressed in black fatigues with a yellow arm patch depicting a black panther, said: "Dr. King said he might not make it there with us. He won't. We're going to fight our way to the promised land."

Many in the audience said they are willing to do whatever is neces sary to improve their lives. But most said they do not think it will come to violence.

"I'm ready to die if I have to," said DeJuan Johnson, a 25-year-old carpenter's aide. "We can't sit back and let our neighborhoods

Indeed, the city has undergone a dramatic economic shift in the past decade that researchers say has most hurt blacks, 40 percent of whom in Milwaukee live below the poverty level.

While nonmanufacturing and aervice jobs have created boom times for the business core, Milwaukee has lost tens of thousands of factory jobs that lured blacks to the city in the first place. Some researchers put the black unemployment rate in the inner city at 25 percent, as against 5 percent for the city overall

Everyday Discrimination

A recent study conducted for the Milwaukee City Council showed that blacks in Milwaukee are discriminated against in many ev-eryday matters.

Last year, researchers from the University of Chicago listed Milwaukee — where most blacks live on the North Side, and most whites live on the South — as one of five American cities whose patterns of segregation were so pronounced and so deeply entrenched that they were deemed "bypersegregated." The other cities were Chicago, Detroit, Cleveland and Newcago, Detroit, Cleveland and New

But compared with some poor cities in the South, where impover-ished blacks may live in shantles without indoor plumbing, racia discrimination is subtle in Milwau kee, black residents say.

"It's a very clean city with a clean kind of racism," said Jerrel

Jones, president of Courier Communications, owner of two black newspapers and a black radio sta-tion in Milwaukee. "You don't see a ghetto as such. But if you knock on a door on our side of town, 25 people might come out who haven't eaten in a week."

Whites Acknowledge Disperity

Many white city officials con-cede that more should be done to belp blacks, who make up about a fourth of the population. But they say threats of violence are only iding McGee's message.

"Whether intended or not, the words of Alderman McGee have created a lot of dissension and divi-siveness in the city," said Alder-man John R. Kalwitz, who is white.

"He scares people," said Thomas P. Donegan, the president of the City Council, who is white. "There's a sense of outrage that anyone would dare threaten to use your."

The 40-year-old McGee, who was an Army medic in the Viet-nam War, has been a renegade on the council since he was first elect-ed in 1984.

He is considered a passionate and committed spokesman for the dispossessed, one who will do al-most anything to get his point

Once he hung a black baby doll from a tree inside the City Hall rotunda to symbolize racism in Miwaukee. Another time he wore a paper bag over his head in an official council portrait to protest lack of financing for the needs of blacks.

Money for Sports

In recent years, while his dis-trict slipped further into poverty, trict shpped further into poverty, development elsewhere has accelerated with new shopping malls and skyscrapers, a new home for the Milwaukee Bucks basketball team, efforts to get a hockey team and plans for a new baseball stadium for the Milwaukee Brewers, which alone could cost \$100 million.

"People tell me, "Mike, you want to move too fast," McGee said. "But they move fast when they want something downtown. Our community cannot take a back seat to baseball and basket-

ball."

For now, he said, his militia will spend its time patrolling black neighborhoods and fighting crime and drugs, much like the Black Muslims have in Washington, D.C. But he said he is ready to fight if black neighborhoods do not get more attention by 1995.

more attention by 1995.

"I'm not advocating what the Black Panthers were advocating," McGee said. "Our militia will be about violence. I'm talking actual fighting, bloodshed and urban guerrilla warfare." The Black Panthers advocated self-defense, not violent attacks, and promoted community social programs.

Politics of Discomfort'

McGee's brand of politics is coming to be known around here as "the politics of discomfort."

"He certainly is pricking our conscience about the real world," Kalwitz said. "It's a legitimate question. Where are our priorities when you spend millions for downtown amenities and dribbles for the neighborhood?" the neighborhood?

Others are not so convinced.

A Milwaukee, Wis., alderman who has threatened terrorist attacks if conditions in Milwaukee's inner city don't improve rushed the stage of ABC's "Good Morning America" Tuesday during its tour of the American heartland.

Police said Michael McGee and four others received disor-derly-conduct citations after they blew whistles and created a disturbance as the television show taped its morning program at a park near Lake Michigan.

'Good Morning' co-host Joan Lunden had just begun listing some of the city's highlights when McGee shouted that Milwaukee had homeless and hungry residents. The whistles could be heard on the program, but McGee did not appear on camera.

At another level - and again despite clear facts to the contrary - insistence that certain tactics avoid "provoking violence" (when it is already massive) or that by remaining nonviolent pacifism can "morally compel" the state to respond in kind must be considered as deep-seated and persistent delusions.

Finally, it must be pointed out that many supposed "deeply principled" adherents are systematically deluding them selves that they are really pacifistic at all. This facet of the symptom is marked by a consistent avoidance of personal physical risk, an over-weaning attitude of personal superiority vis a vis those who "fail" to make overt professions of nonviolence, and sporadic lapses into rather unpacifistic modes of conduct in interpersonal contexts (as opposed to relations with the state).

Pacifism is suicidal: In its core impulse to prostrate itself

Pacifism possesses a sublime arrogance in its implicit assumption that its adherence somehow holds the ability to dictate the terms of struggle in any contestation with the state.

 Pacificism is racist: In displacing massive state violence onto people of color both outside and inside the mother country, rather than absorbing any real measure of it themselves (even when their physical intervention might undercut some of the state's ability to inflict violence on nonwhites), pacifism can only be viewed as being objec-

> Racism itself has been accurately defined as a pathology. 63 Within the context of pacifism, the basic strain must be considered as complicated by an extremely convoluted process of victim-blaming passing itself under the guise of "anti-racism" (a matter linking back to the abovementioned delusional characteristics of the pathology of pacifism).

Finally, both displacement of violence and victim-blam intertwine in their establishment of a comfort zone for whites who utilize it (perhaps entirely subconsciously) as a basis for "prefiguring" a complex of future "revolutionary" social relations which would serve to largely replicate the present priviledged social position of whites, vis a vis nonwhites, as a cultural/intellectual "elite."

> The cluster of subparts encompassed by this overall aspect of the pacifist pathology is usually marked by a pronounced tendency on the part of those suffering the illness to react emotionally and with considerable defensiveness to any discussion (in some cases, mere mention) of the nature of racist behaviors. The behavior is typically manifested in agitated assertions — usually with no accusatory finger having been pointed — to the effect that "I have nothing to be ashamed of" or "I have no reason to feel guilty." As with any pathology, this is the proverbial tell-tale clue indicating s/he is subliminally aware that s/he has much to be ashamed of and is experiencing considerable guilt as a result. Such avoidance may, in extreme cases, merge once again with delusional characteristics of the nathology.

While it seems certain that at least a portion of pacifism's propensity toward suicide is born of the earlier mentioned delusion that it can immpell nonviolence on the part of the state (and is therefore simply erroneous), there is a likelihood that one of two other factors is at work in

before the obvious reality of the violence inherent to state power, pacifism not only inverts Emiliano Zapata's famous-dictim that "It is better to die on one's feet than to live on one's knees," it actually posits the proposition that it is best to die on the latter and seeks to achieve

this result as a matter of principle.

A sublimated deathwish manifesting itself in a rather commonly remarked "gambler's neurosis" (ie: "Can I risk everything and win?").

2) A desublimated deathwish manifesting itself in a "political" equivalent of walking out in front of a bus (ie: "Will it hit me or not?")

In any event, the suicidal characteristic of the pathology may be assumed to follow the contours of other suicide impulses, centering on repressed guilt neuroses and associated feelings of personal inadequacy (in all probability linked to the above-mentioned subliminal racism) and severely complicated by a delusional insistence that the deathwish itself constitutes a "pro-life" impetus.* It is interesting to note that the latter claim has been advanced relative to European Jews during the 1940s.

From even this scanty profile, it is easy enough to discern that pacifism — far from being a praxis adequate to impell revolutionary change — assumes the configuration of a pathological illness when advanced as a political methodology. Given its deep seated, superficially self-serving and socially approved nature, it is likely to be an exceedingly difficult pathology to treat and a long-term barrier to the tion of revolutionary consciousness/action in the United

Inside of house destroyed to beat IRS

BEAVERTON — When Colin McCoy learned that the Internal Revenue Service might foreclose on his Sorrento Bluffs home, he decided to remodel inside - with

a chain saw.

Last week he fired up a rented chain saw and set to work cutting deep gouges in the home's hardwood floors. He also sawed through several support beams in the attic above the garage. McCoy destroyed the home's

oak cabinets and paneling, ripping out cupboards and drawers, gouging holes in paneling and even whittling on the oak handrail to

the staircase.

He tore the living room curtains, cut holes in the carpet, shattered the brass-appointed basin in the main bathroom and punched hundreds of holes in the home's drywall with a hammer.


McCoy left a handwritten mes-sage on the living room wall for the home's new owners. The mes-sage reads in part: "This is my response to the current position held by the IRS ... I have turned my home into a piece of (admit-tedly abstract) art. I have titled it — 'A scorched earth defense against Tyrants.'

Beaverton police responded to McCoy's address when neighbors reported hearing the whine of a chain saw inside the house. They took a report and left. In America, there's no law against home owners decorating their homes as they see fit.

There was a method to McCoy's apparent madness, he said. It hurt, but he was careful to inflict only enough damage to the S142 (W) began to match his coul. \$142,000 home to match his equi which he estimates is \$40,000 to \$50,000.

If the IRS does put his house on the auction block, McCoy figures the feds won't collect a thin dime after the bank takes what is still owed on the loan

"It was extremely painful be-



cause there was no choice," McCoy said. "What I would have had to surrender to the tactics and immorality of the IRS would have cost more.
This way at least I can live with
myself."
So what happened? Three years

ago McCoy, now 28, was a successful businessman. He grew up in Washington County and graduated from Tigard High School in 1980.

In 1985, he bought Heritage Carpet Cleaners in Tualatin and quickly

built up the one-office operation into a million-dollar carpet-cleaning em-pire with 100 employees and offices in Eugene, Spokane, Des Moines and Oklahoma City.

The trouble started when

The trouble started when Heritage's Des Moines office was destroyed in a suspected arson fire. McCoy's insurance company refused to pay up until Heritage reopened its doors.

McCoy gambled the company's tax fund to reopen in Des Moines, but the insurance company still welsted McCoy have recomed 80 exp.

shed. McCoy later recovered 80 percent of the settlement he was seek ing, but the lawsuit dragged on for itwo years.

Meanwhile, cash flow problems from the Des Moines fire hampered the Oklahoma City operation. Heavy rains in Oklahoma that year caused the roof to cave in, and rivulets of water flowed down the middle of the

office floor.

"The days of Camelot were over," McCoy said. After stabilizing the West Coast operation, McCoy sold the business in 1988 in a five-year deal that would have raised enough money to cover the company's outstanding

loans and back taxes to the IRS.

Would have if the new owner
hadn't defaulted on his payments after the first three months. McCoy got the business back through receivership, but the company was in a shambles.

Gang rumor on E-mail shocking

■ Computer hoax causes thousands of calls to police departments

By Robert Salladay

An unbridled rumor shaped by common fears about gang violence is traveling at lightning speed around the country, thanks to a network of compu-ter-mail users. fax machines and mis-chievous hackers.

Police and sheriff's departments around the state have been taking sands of calls from people worried that an "urgent advisory" from San Jose, Sacramento and San Bernardino County law agents may be real.

The hoax: A new gang initiation calls for recruits to drive around with their lights off. The first friendly motorist who does a courtesy flash to warn them gets shot dead.

"It's false, it's not true," moaned a frustrated San Jose Sgt. Don Moore, who said the department has received hundreds of calls about the rumor.

In Sacramento, the police department has been tending off thousands of calls 24 hours a day from worried residents. according to spokeswoman Claudia Evans.

The rumor has grown into a mon-

"We have been just totally inun-ted." Evans said. "It's kind of just dated." Evans said. "It's taken on a life of its own."

The problem has a particularly modern twist: Electronic-mail users who are hooked up to the global Internet system can send messages to thousands of people within sec-

Evans believes that even more people are receiving the rumor through a huge network of fax A new memo faxed Friday claimed to be from the San Bernardino Sheriff's Department. It quoted a man named "Grady Harn" in the Sacramento Police Department, who has never been an employee there, Evans said.

"Be cautious if encountering any autos with lights off this weekend," the fax advisory reads, in part. Today and Sunday would initiation days for the

"Bloods" gang, it warned.
"We didn't initiate it and we have nothing to do with it," said San Bernardino Sheriff's spokeswoman Laurie Savage. "The fax has our name on it, isn't that sweet.

Bay Area newspapers were faxed a copy of the "advisory" Friday from someone within the San Francisco office of the California Department of Correc-

"We thought maybe you might "We thought maybe you might want to hear about it," said a worker there who did not want to leave her name. "It's just some-thing we're spreading every-where. You can never be too careful.

Another "advisory," allegedly Another "advisory." allegedly from the San Jose police, was spread nationally through the In-ternet. The Fremont Argus was faxed a copy of an E-mail printout from an employee at Tandem Computers in Santa Clara County

"It's a big issue out here," said an employee, who also wanted to remain anonymous.
"An associate has a friend who has a friend who says the initiation really happens. . . . 1 believe

WASHINGTON - A leading en-WASHINGTON — A leading en-vironmental group accused the U.S. oil industry of spilling and leaking 1,000 times more oil each year than was spilled by the Exxon Valdez in Alaska four years

Friends of the Earth, in a 234-page report released Sunday, blasted the oil industry for a pattern of inefficient operations that allows leakage, venting, spilling and evaporation of oil on a daily

The group, using what it said were data from federal and state governments as well as other sources, including the American Petroleum Institute, said that 11 billion gallons a year is lost through such means.

American Petroleum Institute

Vice President William O'Keefe called the findings "utter nonsense," saying it would be against the industry's financial interest to allow so much oil to escape.

He said he had seen only a summary of the report, and con-

tortions and inaccuracies couldn't have been by accid cause there are too many of them This is a deliberate attempt to mislead and inflict some sort of Friends of the Earth President

Jane Perkins said the group speeded up release of its report in hopes of influencing the debate on the administration's proposed tax on energy. The oil industry ses the tax: Friends of the Earth

She said she had given a copy of the report to White House Chief of Staff Mack McLarty.

In one area, the report said many of the nation's 700,000 oil storage tanks have leaked under-ground pools of oil that contami-nate soil and water.

"Among tanks known to be leaking, some have each released more than was lost from the Exxon Valdez" off the shores of Alaska in 1989, the report said.

EPA spokesman Dave Cohen said the agency had not seen the report and had no comment on it.

However, an EPA official who spoke on condition of anonymity said the report's findings sounded consistent with the agency's data. oke on condition of anonymity

Bank robbery ends with cash on the grill





13,000-Volt Electric Line Falls Near New Jersey Gas Pipeline

EDISON, N.J., April 29 — An overhead electrical line, crackling and burning, fell near a gas pipeline early Thursday, rekindling memories of the natural-gas main explosion here five weeks ago and creating a new round of safety jitters in City Hall.
The downed 13,000-volt electrical line, in a secluded area in southeastern Edison, burned a 2½-foot-deep hole in the ground, reaching within two feet of a gas transmission line, before the electricity was turned off, Mayor George A. Spadoro said today. The line was on the ground for two hours before the Public Service Electric & Gas Company shut off electricity to it, the Mayor said. The Edison Fire Department notified a utility dispatcher of the problem at 12:37 A.M. Thursday. The power was shut off at 2:23 A.M. he said.

The following information is taken from a speech by Mark Koernke who lists, among his credentials, his stints as an intelligence analyst with the Fifth US Army Intelligence Center, as well as a commander of special warfare brigade units that train US military forces in foreign warfare and tactics.

FEMA - Federal Emergency Management Agency

FEMA employs approximately 3,600 people, only 60 of whom actually deal with emergency situations such as earthquakes. The rest of the personnel's mission is to prepare to implement an emergency government and manage the system after social and economic collapse. To this end, there are now 43 detention camps set up across the country, with supplementary or auxillary camps set up through each state and region. The main processing center for detainees in the western half of the US is in Oklahoma City, and the eastern half will probably be Fort Drum in New York.

MJTF - Multi Jurisdictional Task Force

The MJTF's primary mission is house to house search and seizure, seperation and categorisation of men, women, and children in large numbers, and the transfer of detainees to detention faci lities and the use of these facilities for interrogation purposes. MJTF guidelines state that "house to house search and seizures will be performed by military, law enforcement and civilian personnel." This means national guard, local cops, and street gangs converted to national police services. Negotiations with street gangs have taken place in Chicago, New York and Los Angeles. The Crips and Bloods in LA are now being trained, equipped and uniformed with federal funding processed through California. The main objective of the MJTF is to disarm the population. To this end they have carried out three known operations: Operation Achilles in 1991, Operation Clean Sweep in late 92 to early 93, and Operation Achilles II.

Operation Achilles was a sweep from the southern Ohio valley up through to Michigan by the combined forces of the MJTF and the BATF (Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms). Their objective was to harass and eliminate FFL (Federal Firearms License) holders who were manufacturers and producers of components and arms. The only thing taken in the raids were records of who purchased products and where they lived.

Operation Clean Sweep in late 92 took place in Chicago. The MJTF blocked off neighborhoods, went building to building, door to door, entered forcibly if necessary, and prosecuted owners of

firearms, ammunition, and gun parts.

Operation Achilles II involved MJTF units from several different areas in Ohio, who were transfered to an area outside of the Cleveland airport. A "mount area" was set up with three neighborhoods, which they secured one by one.

Other MJTF operations include a series of actions in LA after the riots against citizens who were defending themseves. As well, the BATF were probably under MJTF authority at Waco, Texas.

FINCEN's primary mission is much the same as MJTF - the house to house searches, seperation and categorisation of detainees, and their transfer to detention facilities. FINCEN will also secure properties acquired during raids, and they will not be involved in the maintaining of the detention camps; this is MJTF's role. FINCEN forces and personnel are drawn from military and secret police forces overseas, predominantly European. These include Belgian, Dutch, German, French, and a variety of Asian military personnel. FINCEN elements are located in Montana, northern and southern California, central Texas, northern N. Carolina, Fort Drum in New York and along the eastern seaboard including Wash. DC. The element in Montana is partially made up of Gurkhas. The main equipment to be used by FINCEN are Chinook CH-47 helicopters, as they can carry up to 64 people. FINCEN will also control ground operations through the Chinooks, as well as pick up and transfer detainees. Detainees will be delivered to temporary sites - POL (petrolium, oil, and lubrication) points, and then transfered to primary detention sites or sorting facilities where it will be determined whether or not the person is a high



We have less species of animals and plants now. We have more polluted air, water, and food. Life is dying all around us while corporate fucks and the brainless masses concern themselves with money and things. Have you noticed? If you get your news primarily from the corporations through tv and newspapers, you probably haven't noticed. The struggle for liberation and freedom for all species and the Earth continues. It's time to notice. It's time to help the struggle. It's time to get involved, because there just isn't much time left. If you're interested, read on. If not, go back to watching America's Most Wanted. You never know, you might just see your friends there. Then will you care?


The April 94 issue of Militant Vegan reports that there have been "more than 20 ac ts of sabotage and liberation in just the first 2 months" of 1994 in North America. By including vandalism and other minor attacks, the list grows to over 40. That's not counting what we'll never hear about. These figures mean that some kind of action happens almost every day.

In the first 3 months of this year, we've taken some blows as well. In Edmonton. the prosecutor of an ALF activist has appealled the sentence handed down to Darren Thurston. Paul Moreau wants to put Darren in a cell for three more years on top of the 15 months he already spent inside. (As of this writing, the judge has not made a decision.) In Spokane, appeals by grand jury prisoners Deb Stout and Kim Trimiew were denied, and the two remain in jail for refusing to talk about the ALF, for Kim it's her second time. They have been inside since Feb. 18 and can expect to remain there until at least the fall. Arizona has become the most recent state to create laws specifically to criminalize animal liberation activists. There are already federal laws in place. Grand juries are continuing until at least mid 1995 in five states (OR, WA, MI, UT, LA). Direct FBI harassment of activists continues in at least 3 states so far this year, and the feds are still looking for several others, one of whom has his very own post office "wanted" poster. (I don't have to tell you what to



Does this sound pretty bad to you? We need to remember that what this all really means, what it reflects, is the growth of our movement. There are now more brave sister and brother warriors forming cells and tribes and taking action. What it also means is that we have to be much more careful and smart in our daily activities. The "political climate" is not what it was ten or even five years ago. Now, in the mid-nineties, mistakes will be hard and costly. Follow the basic rules: don't use phones for anything, use only safe addresses for mail, shut your mouth - do not say anything to anyone, etc., etc. You know it all, right? Well, I hope so.

As the evolution of the struggle continues in this way and the attempts to squash it increase, we will see more of our brothers and sisters either in jail or on the run. We need to accept this as a reality because people do fuck up, and sometimes the feds do get lucky. We need to prepare ourselves for the increased repression. The first steps to take are to thoroughly clean your home, to get new i.d., and to start stashes of needed things such as money, food, gear, etc.

It doesn't matter whether you are active or not. If you have any friends or connections at all to active resistance fighters, then you may find yourself in need of i.d. at some point. Making your home safe means having all personal letters, diaries, photos, papers and magazines advocating illegal activities, and any related items such as that timing device you have been working on for months, it means having all'this stuff out of your home and into a safe place. It may seem a bit inconvenient and perhaps unnecessary, but I tell ya, 5 - 10 years in a cell will be a lot more inconvenient. Also remember that someone else's actions in your city or neighborhood could precipitate a raid on your home even if you had nothing to do with it.

If you are an active warrior, you should consider ending your public life and begin your private one. There are a few activists who are living this way now, and so far none have been caught. One thing to consider is that all the people the feds are physically harassing right now, and all the activists who are or have gone to jail, have all been public people with all connections leading to their homes, jobs, friends, etc. An activist is much more secure and safe away from prying eyes, if s/he is a private person. A private life as an activist-means not going to any public political rallies and demos, meetings or similar events. It means dropping out of a public existance as much as possible.

In this private life many new issues will come up that are sometimes not so easily dealt with. This includes loneliness and isolation, especially if you make a complete break from traditional friends and family. This is why the idea of a tribe is so important. We need eachother for our psychic and emotional well-being, to enable us to cope and survive. This break from those friends and family does become necessary when you realize that those who lead public lives often do not fully understand your security needs. Many mista kes will happen such as mentioning your name over the phone or in the presence of others who will repeat the information to someone else. Your friends will do this, no matter how many times you've tried to explain the situation to them. Until your friends and relatives really and truly understand the level of security you need. it is wisest to have as little contact as possible with them. For those who do begin to understand, encourage them to get a safe address, and if you have one yourself (which you should) you can now safely communicate with eachother through the

Other issues that will come up tend to revolve around home and money. About the former, it is best not to live with people who can testify as to whether you were home on a certain day, or what friends you have, or where you might have travelled. Will your housemates be brave

enough and have the integrity to refuse to answer questions to an agent or a grand jury? Will they too choose jail over talking? Do you really know their breaking point? Think about it. Perhaps your current home situation needs to be changed. Living on your own or with your comrades is the best. Living on the road is also an alternative. Whatever you decide to do, do it safely. No phones, no mail, do not arouse the suspicions of your neighbors. We are now in the era of safe actions and safe living.

The central issue that will keep coming up is the one of money. If you've been thinking ahead and have been part of the slave force, maybe you've put away a few thousand. Or maybe you've got some left over from grandma's inheritance. Eventually though, your personal supply will run out. A job is out of the question when you're leading a private activist life. Besides, there's so much real work to be done. So how will you survive? Surviving costs money, whether it's for food (you will need to cut down on shoplifting as it poses a huge risk to your survival) or for research work or for those tools, or for gas or for the occasional car rental or motel room. It all adds up.

Unfortunately, money is the one thing I haven't completely figured out yet. You can try your folks or your working friends to donate to your needs, or maybe you or they know of richer sympathetic folks. For those of you reading this who have been approached for money, or know of activists who need it, put your thinking caps on and to figure this one out. The reality is, without the cash flow, ain't nothing much gonna happen.

This may sound so dire and depressing and especially difficult. This road is certainly not for everyone. Careful consideration must be given to this decision. Hard questions must be asked of yourself: Do I really think that letter writing, petitioning, marching, shouting, civil disobedience, and banner hanging will really change anything before it's too late? Is it almost too late already? Is there something more that needs to be done? Am I one of those people who needs to be doing that "something more"? There's nothing more this planet needs right now than committed Earth warriors. Think about it.

One thing I would like to touch on briefly is one not many people give much thought or credit to. That thing is magic, specifically, magical protection. Amid your scoffing and teasing I can happily say that there is magical energy to tap into. Most of my protection, outside of all the practical precautions I take, comes from my faith in the magical realm. This is not to say I've ignored my own advice or acted callously, but much of my safety and security is greatly enhanced by my knowledge and understanding and "tuning in" to the magic around me. I look at it as a kind of chaos of energy which engulfs and connects every being and place. Once you learn to see signs of the energy, and begin to connect with the chaos around you, you can tap into the protective energies. There is no rule of how to do this; everybody must find their own way which suits their particular way of relating. A lot of it has to do with faith and a lot has to do with your connection to other like-minded souls as well as the natural world. Anyway, I'm not writing to convert you non-believers. All I'm saving is just open yourself up to the potentials and the possibilities. What have you got to lose?

We have an incredibly enormous task on our hands, which is to help bring the madness to an end. The planet and all creatures on it have suffered long enough at the hands of humans. As conscious people we have the responsibility to stop the destruction, and to do that we must stop the humans and their criminal corporate enterprises. Earth warriors need all the help from you as possible, and we need as many new dedicated souls as possible to join in the struggle. And, we need all the help magic can provide for us as well.

I want to talk a bit more about the support role. Fact is, most of you reading this, no matter how much you agree with the ideas of resistance and direct action, will not participate in it or be prepared to involve vouselves in full-scale resistance. That's unfortunate, but not a complete waste. Truth is, in order for any level of direct action campaigns to continue and flourish, we need people who are not directly involved to offer much needed support. Here are some ideas, some of which have already been mentioned but they can be stressed over and over again.

You likely know someone who is involved in illegal actions. Help to maintain their security. How? By not asking them questions such as "Where are you going?" or "where have you been?" By not talking ab-

out these people to your friends or strangers, casually, over the phone, or otherwise. By refusing to answer questions about them posed to you by anyone, either a close friend or the fbi. By opening your door to them when they need a place to crash, no questions asked. By offering them money when they come through town, because they need it, and their sources are few and far between. Like I said before, money is the main issue as far as support for an underground life and for continued actions is concerned. If you've got a job, consider putting away a set amount each month to support the underground. You may not know anyone now who is in need but in all probability you will sometime in the future. Hit up your wealthy friends and relatives, and they don't need to know what it's for.

There are other things to start acquiring and stashing. Mon-perishable food such as grains and canned goods will always be useful. Know anyone who works in a health food store or even a safeway? With the approach of world disorder, you yourself might just benefit from a well thought out survival plan. Aside from stashing food and money, you might also want to consider acquiring a gun and lots of ammo. Personally, I have no use for such things in 1994, but who's to say what might happen in 5 - 10 years. Every year it's getting harder to get a weapon for personal defense, so the smart thing to do would be to get that stuff now while you still can and simply stash it in one of those army ammo boxes buried in a spot in a national forest or somewhere. I would suggest either a 9mm or 38 with as much ammo as you can afford. If you never need it, great! But if you do need to defend yourself in the future, you will be pre-

The important thing to remember here is that there are people now, our friends, our brothers and sisters, who are, in 1994, on the run, avoiding police detect ion, trying to continue this struggle which we all believe in, carrying out ac tions for the Earth and the animals, and who are barely surviving and only just surviving due to the support, minimal though it is, and good will of some people and friends like you. Ideally, in my fantasy world, every one of you would immediately quit your jobs and your public lives and start your private underground life of activism and resistance. I know that won't happen, so the next best thing is for ya'll to start putting into place measures to support our comrades. Remember, we're out here on the front lines, and we need you! Let's support our troops!



HOW TO REPLACE YOUR LOST ID FROM SCRATCH WHEN YOU'VE LOST EVERYTHING INCLUDING YOUR MIND, YOUR HOME, AND YOUR LIFE

Try to remember the year and month you were born in.

Go to the library and get the newspaper microform for that month.

Read through the birth notices until you find a name you like.

Take down all the information listed in the notice. You probably won't get your father's middle name or your mother's name at all, but you might get her maiden name if the maternal grandparents are listed.

Go to the government office where you can replace your birth cartificate (bc) and fill out the form as best you can. If the clerk asks for the missing information (if they care) just be prepared with a convincing story. "I don't remember my Dad's middle name." Or, "I never knew my mother."

Pay the nice cashier the fee and walk out with your replaced bc.

Move to another state.

Buy an address at the mail box store, the kind with the friendly people who don't ask for i.d. "I've just moved here and lost my i.d. in the process. All I have is my bc, will that be okay?" sometimes works. Or you could have just forgotten your wallet and perhaps you can bring all that stuff in next time...

Mail yourself some letters to your new address. Use different handwritings and type on the envelopes. If you don't have the time, just find some used postage-stamp-cancelled letters and put mailing labels over the addresses and write and type in yours. Acquire a receipt book and write yourself out a rent receipt. Go to the government office where you can replace your SS card. Explain to the nice clerk how you've lost everything and all you have is your bc. She'll likely ask for something, anything else, like a bill or a rent receipt or "how about these letters, will they do?" They sure will!

After she processes your request, be sure to ask for a receipt which shows that you've applied for a replacement card. Make sure your number is writen on it.


While you're in the office, fill out one of those requests for a Personal Earnings and Benefit Estimate Statement and mail it off. You might as well know how much money you're making.

Check out the driver's license/state id government office to see what they require for id. Sometimes just a bc and your SS number will do. Sometimes you need to get a library card in addition. Library cards are sometimes more difficult than d.l.s. It's good to have more that your bc, SSN receipt, rent receipt, and some letters.

Find one of those check cashing stores and get a photo i.d.

How about a community center or health club membership card?

Once you have your d.l. and SS card, you're almost a complete citizen again! You can't really work on the SSN or get a passport, but you can drive around and be you as best you can!

PLAN TO SAVE ENDANGERED RANCHERS ANNOUNCED BY USFCS

A very unusual plan to save two subspecies of Endangered public lands ranchers was recently released by the U.S. Fish & Critter Service (USFCS). Only about 22,000 public lands ranchers remain in the entire Western United States. Two distinct subspecies have been identified - the pea-brained and the big-mouthed.

Tom Nelson of USFCS says that approximately 10,000 of the pea-brained and 5,000 of the big-mouthed have been verified to date. He continues, "Preliminary data indicate that all other public lands ranchers are either hybrids of the two known subspecies or some type of mutant

The plan calls for removal of all the ranchers from public lands, an aggressive captive breeding program, retraining, and eventual release to host private lands ranchers.

Under the plan the former public lands ranchers will be trained in horseback riding and range management - two areas for which they seem to have lost all natural ability. In addition to the training, they will be treated for pickup truck addiction and given shock therapy in an attempt to cure them of their tendency to shoot, poison, or run over every native animal on

Howl-at-the-Moon of the radical environmental group Dirt First!, scoffs at the plan. "It's a waste of good taxpayer money. Why do we need to save all subspecies of ranchers? Red-headed ranchers, brown-headed ranchers, what's the difference?"

USFCS admits that there are more than 300,000 private lands ranchers in the West, many and smell like their public lands cousins. Nelson says, "The differences and subtle. We really don't know enough yet to make a call. We are conducting extensive DNA studies of the captive breeding stock to determine the uniqueness of the public lands ranchers.

Tim Morton. New Mexico Representative of The Wilder Earth Society, supports the plan. "Get them [public lands ranchers] off the land, stop the havoc they have been wreaking for decades, and save the taxpayer money -- even if the program fails."

Morton's latter point refers to the billions of dollars that government agencies have pumped into federal range programs in an effort to save public lands ranchers in place.

In a rare move, Dymwitt Johnson, spokesperson for the New Mexico Cattle Pokers and himself a reformed big-mouthed public lands rancher, refused to comment on the plan.



ACTIVISTS BUSTED

DAVID BARBARASH CAPTURED IN SCOTTS VALLEY
Wanted for alleged connection to ALF activities in Canada, Canadian activist
David Barbarash was apprehended at gun-point Monday, May 9, 1994. David
and Jonathan Paul were driving in separate cars coming from Jonathan's
house in Scotts Valley, California (near Santa Cruz) when they noticed a 3-car
police road-block set up on the only street exiting Jonathan's house. As they
slowed down, police surrounded the two and approximately 30 Scotts Valley
officers and FBI agents, complete with semi-automatic rifles, shotguns, and
pistols, took aim at the two activists. Jonathan and David stuck their hands out pistols, took aim at the two activists. Jonathan and David stuck their hands out of their car windows, and they were handcuffed and put into separate cars. The officers then searched both vehicles. David's had just been loaded with his old junk that he was taking to a storage bin. His address book and old boxes containing much literature on animal liberation tactics, methods, and hardware manufacturing, which will undoubtedly be used against him in his future court cases, were found inside. David's car and its contents were impounded as evidence. It is still unknown as to how the authorities knew of David's whereabouts at that particular time, though theories are a-plenty. Jonathan was released, while David, of course, was held on various charges:

petty theft/failure to complete community service hours in Santa Cruz, a 1990 charge and sentence; illegal entry into the U.S.; and the various charges in Canada, which include Breaking and Entering and Arson. You will recall the situations that he is being charged with being involved in, as they are the same actions that activist Darren Thurston served 14 ¹/₂ months for and was sentenced to pay \$73,725 in restitution last year. Restitution goes to the University of Alberta, where 29 cats were liberated, and to the Billingsdale Fish Company, where three trucks were burned. The bulk of evidence against Darren was a 4 ¹/₂-hour video statement by an informant, Jessica Michelle Charlotte Sandham of Calgary this statement will likely be used. Charlotte Sandham of Calgary; this statement will likely be used against David as well. Darren's sentence was appealed by the prosecution (they can do that in Canada unlike the U.S.), and he has returned to prison as of 5/19 and is potentially facing 2 more years behind bars.

David will now go through a complex procedure that has begun with his minor court hearing in Santa Cruz on May 11th for the theft charge in which the judge converted his unserved community service hours to a 3-day sentence which, including time served, he completed that day. While in the U.S. a lawyer has been provided for him by the Activist Support Network. He was handed over to Border Patrol authorities on May 12th who detained him in was handed over to Border Patrol authorities on May 12th who detained him in an immigration office in Salinas, CA. He was offered a choice between an immigration hearing with the possibility of posting a \$20,000 bond or voluntary deportation, but then the FBI stepped in wanting to question him about other incidents in the U.S., making his immigration issue secondary and his chance for bail zilch. So, it may be awhile before David sent back to Canada to begin the fiasco up there. Until then he will be held in either L.A. or Livermore, California. Once in Canada, he will more than likely end up in Edmonton. Alberta where Davren was held during his first atay.

Upon last speaking with David we learned that he was doing as well as can be expected. Jail time for a vegan can be pretty painful in a country that believes ketchup to be a vegetable (thanks Prez Reagan!!).

KEY WEST, Fla. — A woman was seriously injured when a large barra-cuda leapt from the water into a houseboat off the Florida Keys and

"I have never in my life been hit by anything that hard." Nadine Cloer said Sunday from a room at Mariner's Hospital in Key Largo.

Family members rushed to help Cloer after the fish lunged at her Saturday and pushed it overboard with eaffs.

Doctors estimated the size of the fish at about 8 feet long, according to the bite wounds she received. Cloer said. It took nearly 200 stitches to close the wounds

Barracudas, long, thin predators with razor-sharp teeth, do not usually attack unless speared or provoked by divers or snorkelers. Cloer, 46, was spending the week end in a rented houseboat fishing with her husband, two sisters and

brother-in-law She said her brother-in-law caught a small barracuda and she then saw another, larger barracuda pass under the boat. She went inside the cabin to get a video camera and as she was

get a video camera and as she was walking out the door, the larger one lunged at her.

The cabin of the 40-foot vessel is set back about 8 feet from the edge. Family members say the fish jumped some 12 to 15 feet. The force knocked Cloer back into the cabin with the fish on too of her. fish on top of her.

"When I arrived she was in a pool when I arrived she was in a pool of blood with everyone trying to stop the bleeding," said Capt. Mitch Schacter of Sea Tow Marine Services, who responded to the distress call from the houseboat.

A doctor said the fish came within his thumb's width of severing an artery in her pelvis, which almost certainly would have killed her.

ANCHORAGE, Alaska - In the land of magnificent beasts and great struggles between civili-zation and nature, a pair of elderly tourists in a Winnebago found out just how cruel nature can

Leddy recounted the incident based on talks with his crew.
Workers were relaxing in various parts of the prefabricated facility about 8 p.m. Tuesday, with Chaffin and another man watching televi-sion and doing crossword puzzles

in the station's lounge.

Chaffin heard a noise at the window and turned to find the bear with its face and paws pressed against the glass.

He swatted at the pane with a rolled-up newspaper or magazine. The bear ducked and then crashed through the window, which Leddy said is about 7 feet off the ground.

Chaffin and the other man in the room bolted for a magnetic door that separates the lounge from adjoining rooms, but the door apparently jammed. The bear then pounced on Chaffin.

"There was no way to protect Don," said Leddy. "He was just brutally attacked."

Shark Devours Newlywed Diving Off Australia

A great white shark devoured a man scuba diving on his honeymoon yesterday, then escap-ed from pursuing fishermen after ramming their boat and spitting out part of its victim.

Police have called in professional shark hunters to capture the shark. The attack, off the resort town of Byron Bay, 400 miles north of Sydney, was Australia's second fatal shark attack in five days. John Ford, 31, had been diving with his bride of 15 days, Deborah, when the shark lunged at them.

Mrs. Ford, 29, told rescue workers that her husband pushed her from the path of the shark. His flippers, torn pieces of a wet suit and a weight belt ere later found in the water. Mrs. Ford was not Fishermen searched for the shark and caught a



Fighting Words on the Future of the Earth

RUSSELL MEANS

The only possible opening for a statement of this kind is that I detest writing. The process itself epitomizes the European concept of "legitimate" thinking; what is written has an importance that is denied the spoken. My culture, the Lakota culture, has an oral tradition, so I ordinarily reject writing. It is one of the white world's ways of destroying the cultures of non-European peoples, the imposing of an abstraction over the spoken relationship of a people. So what you read here is not what I've written. It's what I've said

So what you read here is not what I've written. It's what I've said and someone else has written down. I will allow this because it seems that the only way to communicate with the white world is through the dead, dry leaves of a book. I don't really care whether my words reach whites or not. They have already demonstrated through their history that they cannot hear, cannot see; they can only read (of course, there are exceptions, but the exceptions only prove the rule). I'm more concerned with American Indian people, students and others, who have begun to be absorbed into the white world through universities and other institutions. But even then it's a marginal sort of concern. It's very possible to grow into a red face with a white mind; and if that's a person's individual choice, so be it, but I have no use for them. This is part of the process of cultural genocide being waged by Europeans against American Indian peoples today. My concern is with those American Indians who choose to resist this genocide, but who may be confused as to how to proceed.

(You notice I use the term American Indian rather than Native American or Native indigenous people or Amerindian when referring to my people. There has been some controversy about such terms, and frankly, at this point, I find it absurd. Primarily it seems that American Indian is being rejected as European in origin—which is true. But all the above terms are European in origin; the only non-European way is to speak of Lakota—or, more precisely, of Oglala, Brulé, etc.—and of the Diné, the Miccosukee and all the rest of the several hundred correct tribal names.

(There is also some confusion about the word Indian, a mistaken belief that it refers somehow to the country, India. When Columbus washed up on the beach in the Caribbean, he was not looking for a country called India. Europeans were calling that country Hindustan in 1492. Look it up on the old maps. Columbus called the tribal people he met "Indio", from the Italian in dio, meaning "in Cod")

It takes a strong effort on the part of each American Indian not to become Europeanized. The strength for this effort can only come from the traditional ways, the traditional values that our elders retain. It must come from the hoop, the four directions, the relations; it cannot come from the pages of a book or a thousand books. No European can ever teach a Lakota to be Lakota, a Hopi to be Hopi. A master's degree in "Indian Studies" or in "education" or in anything else cannot make a person into a human being or provide knowledge into the traditional ways. It can only make you into a mental European, an outsider.

I should be clear about something here, because there seems to be some confusion about it. When I speak of Europeans or mental Europeans, I'm not allowing for false distinctions. I'm not saying that on the one hand there are the by-products of a few thousand years of genocidal, reactionary, European intellectual development

which is bad; and on the other hand there is some new revolutionary intellectual development which is good. I'm referring here to the so-called theories of Marxism and anarchism and "leftism" in general. I don't believe these theories can be separated from the rest of the European intellectual tradition. It's really just the same old song.

The process began much earlier. Newton, for example, "revolutionized" physics and the so-called natural sciences by reducing the physical universe to a linear mathematical equation. Descartes did the same thing with culture. John Locke did it with politics, and Adam Smith did it with economics. Each one of these "thinkers" took a piece of the spirituality of human existence and converted it into a code, an abstraction. They picked up where Christianity ended; they "secularized" Christian religion, as the "scholars" like to say — and in doing so they made Europe more able and ready to act as an expansionist culture. Each of these intellectual revolutions served to abstract the European mentality even further, to remove the wonderful complexity and spirituality from the universe and replace it with a logical sequence: one, two, three, Answer!

This is what has come to be termed "efficiency" in the European mind. Whatever is mechanical is perfect; whatever seems to work at the moment — that is, proves the mechanical model to be the right one — is considered correct, even when it is clearly untrue. This is why "truth" changes so fast in the European mind; the answers which result from such a process are only stop-gaps, only temporary, and must be continuously discarded in favor of new stop-gaps which support the mechanical models and keep them (the models) alive.

support the mechanical models and keep them (the models) alive. Hegel and Marx were heirs to the thinking of Newton, Descartes, Locke and Smith. Hegel finished the process of secularizing theology—and that is put in his own terms—he secularized the religious thinking through which Europe understood the universe. Then Marx put Hegel's philosophy in terms of "materialism", which is to say that Marx despiritualized Hegel's work altogether. Again, this is in Marx's own terms. And this is now seen as the future revolutionary potential of Europe. Europeans may see this as revolutionary, but American Indians see it simply as still more of that same old European conflict between being and gaining. The intellectual roots of a new Marxist form of European imperialism lie in Marx's—and his followers'—links to the tradition of Newton, Hegel and the others.

Being is a spiritual proposition. Gaining is a material act. Traditionally, American Indians have always attempted to be the best people they could. Part of that spiritual process was and is to give away wealth, to discard wealth in order not to gain. Material gain is an indicator of false status among traditional people, while it is "proof that the system works" to Europeans. Clearly, there are two completely opposing views at issue here, and Marxism is very far over to the other side from the American Indian view. But let's look at a major implication of this; it is not merely an intellectual debate.

The European materialist tradition of despiritualizing the universe is very similar to the mental process which goes into dehumanizing another person. And who seems most expert at dehumanizing other people? And why? Soldiers who have seen a lot of combat learn to do this to the enemy before going back into combat. Murderers do it before going out to commit murder. Nazi SS guards did it to concentration camp inmates. Cops do it. Corporation leaders do it to the workers they send into uranium mines and steel mills. Politicians do it to everyone in sight. And what the process has in common for each group doing the dehumanizing is that it makes it all right to kill and otherwise destroy other people. One of the Christian commandments says, "Thou shalt not kill", at least not humans, so the trick is to mentally

convert the victims into nonhumans. Then you can proclaim violation of your own commandment as a virtue.

In terms of the despiritualization of the universe, the mental process works so that it becomes virtuous to destroy the planet. Terms like progress and development are used as cover words here, the way victory and freedom are used to justify butchery in the dehumanization process. For example, a real-estate speculator may refer to "developing" a parcel of ground by opening a gravel quarry; development here means total, permanent destruction, with the earth itself removed. But European logic has gained a few tons of gravel with which more land can be "developed" through the construction of road beds. Ultimately, the whole universe is open — in the European view — to this sort of insanity.

Most important here, perhaps, is the fact that Europeans feel no sense of loss in all this. After all, their philosophers have despiritualized reality, so there is no satisfaction (for them) to be gained in simply observing the wonder of a mountain or a lake or a people in being. No, satisfaction is measured in terms of gaining material. So the mountain becomes gravel, and the lake becomes coolant for a factory, and the people are rounded up for processing through the indoctrination mills Europeans like to call schools.

But each new piece of that "progress" ups the ante out in the real world. Take fuel for the industrial machine as an example. Little more than two centuries ago, nearly everyone used wood — a replenishable, natural item — as fuel for the very human needs of cooking and staying warm. Along came the Industrial Revolution and coal became the dominant fuel, as production became the social imperative for Europe. Pollution began to become a problem in the cities, and the earth was ripped open to provide coal whereas wood had always simply been gathered or harvested at no great expense to the environment. Later, oil became the major fuel, as the technology of production was perfected through a series of scientific "revolutions". Pollution increased dramatically, and nobody yet knows what the environmental costs of pumping all that oil out of the ground will really be in the long run. Now there's an "energy crisis", and uranium is becoming the dominant fuel.

crisis", and uranium is becoming the dominant fuel.

Capitalists, at least, can be relied upon to develop uranium as fuel only at the rate at which they can show a good profit. That's their ethic, and maybe that will buy some time. Marxists, on the other hand, can be relied upon to develop uranium fuel as rapidly as possible simply because it's the most "efficient" production fuel available. That's their ethic, and I fail to see where it's preferable. Like I said, Marxism is right smack in the middle of the European tradition. It's the same old song.

There's a rule of thumb which can be applied here. You cannot judge the real nature of a European revolutionary doctrine on the basis of the changes it proposes to make within the European power structure and society. You can only judge it by the effects it will have on non-European peoples. This is because every revolution in European history has served to reinforce Europe's tendencies and abilities to export destruction to other peoples, other cultures and the environment itself. I defy anyone to point out an example where this is not true.

So now we, as American Indian people, are asked to believe that a "new" European revolutionary doctrine such as Marxism will reverse the negative effects of European history on us. European power relations are to be adjusted once again, and that's supposed to make things better for all of us. But what does this really mean?

Right now, today, we who live on the Pine Ridge Reservation are living in what white society has designated a "National Sacrifice Area". What this means is that we have a lot of uranium deposits here, and white culture (not us) needs this uranium as energy production material. The cheapest, most efficient way for industry to extract and deal with the processing of this uranium is to dump the waste by-products right here at the digging sites. Right here where we live. This waste is radioactive and will make the entire region uninhabitable forever. This is considered by industry, and by the white society that created this industry, to be an "acceptable" price to pay for energy resource development. Along the way they also plan to drain the water table under this part of South Dakota as part of the industrial process, so the region becomes doubly uninhabitable. The same sort of thing is happening down in the land of the Navajo and Hopi, up in the land of the Northern Cheyenne and Crow, and elsewhere. Thirty percent of the coal in the West and half of the uranium deposits in the US have been found to lie under reservation land, so there is no way this can be called a minor issue.

We are resisting being turned into a National Sacrifice Area. We are resisting being turned into a national sacrifice people. The costs of this industrial process are not acceptable to us. It is genocide to discuss in the water table.—no more no less

dig uranium here and drain the water table — no more, no less.

Now let's suppose that in our resistance to extermination we begin to seek allies (we have). Let's suppose further that we were to take revolutionary Marxism at its word: that it intends nothing less than the complete overthrow of the European capitalist order which has presented this threat to our very existence. This would seem to be a natural alliance for American Indian people to enter into. After all, as the Marxists say, it is the capitalists who set us up to be a national sacrifice. This is true as far as it goes.


But, as I've tried to point out, this "truth" is very deceptive. Revolutionary Marxism is committed to even further perpetuation and perfection of the very industrial process which is destroying us all. It offers only to "redistribute" the results — the money, maybe — of this industrialization to a wider section of the population. It offers to take wealth from the capitalists and pass it around; but in order to do so, Marxism must maintain the industrial system. Once again, the power relations within European society will have to be altered, but once again the effects upon American Indian peoples here and non-Europeans elsewhere will remain the same. This is much the same as when power was redistributed from the church to private business during the so-called bourgois revolution. European society changed a bit, at least superficially, but its conduct toward non-Europeans continued as before. You can see what the American Revolution of 1776 did for American Indians. It's the same old song.


Revolutionary Marxism, like industrial society in other forms, seeks to "rationalize" all people in relation to industry — maximum industry, maximum production. It is a materialist doctrine that despises the American Indian spiritual tradition, our cultures, our lifeways. Marx himself called us "precapitalists" and "primitive". Precapitalist simply means that, in his view, we would eventually discover capitalism and become capitalists; we have always been economically retarded in Marxist terms. The only manner in which American Indian people could participate in a Marxist revolution would be to join the industrial system, to become factory workers, or "proletarians" as Marx called them. The man was very clear about the fact that his revolution could occur only through the struggle of the proletariat, that the existence of a massive industrial system is a precondition of a successful Marxist society.

I think there's a problem with language here. Christians, capitalists, Marxists. All of them have been revolutionary in their own minds, but none of them really mean revolution. What they really mean is a continuation. They do what they do in order that European culture can continue to exist and develop according to its

So, in order for us to really join forces with Marxism, we American Indians would have to accept the national sacrifice of our homeland; we would have to commit cultural suicide and become industrialized and Europeanized.

At this point, I've got to stop and ask myself whether I'm being too harsh. Marxism has something of a history. Does this history bear out my observations? I look to the process of industrialization

In Marxist terms I suppose I'm a "cultural nationalist". I work first with my people, the traditional Lakota people, because we hold a common world view and share an immediate struggle. Beyond this, I work with other traditional American Indian peoples, again because of a certain commonality in world view and form of struggle. Beyond that, I work with anyone who has experienced the colonial oppression of Europe and who resists its cultural and industrial totality. Obviously, this includes genetic Caucasians who struggle to resist the dominant norms of European culture. The Irish and the Basques come immediately to mind, but there are many others.

I work primarily with my own people, with my own community. Other people who hold non-European perspectives should do the same. I believe in the slogan, "Trust your brother's vision", although I'd like to add sisters into the bargain. I trust the community and the culturally based vision of all the races that naturally resist industrialization and human extinction. Clearly, individual whites can share in this, given only that they have reached the awareness that continuation of the industrial imperatives of Europe is not a vision, but species suicide. White is one of the sacred colors of the Lakota people — red, yellow, white and black. The four directions. The four seasons. The four periods of life and aging. The four races of humanity. Mix red, yellow, white and black together and you get brown, the colour of the fifth race. This is a natural ordering of things. It therefore seems natural to me to work with all races, each with its own special meaning, identity and message.

But there is a peculiar behaviour among most Caucasians. As soon as I became critical of Europe and its impact on other cultures, they become defensive. They begin to defend themselves. But I'm not attacking them personally; I'm attacking Europe. In personalizing my observations on Europe they are personalizing European culture, identifying themselves with it. By defending themselves in this context, they are ultimately defending the death culture. This is a confusion which must be overcome, and it must be overcome in a hurry. None of us have energy to waste in such false struggles.

Caucasians have a more positive vision to offer humanity than European culture. I believe this. But in order to attain this vision it is necessary for Caucasians to step outside European culture — alongside the rest of humanity — to see Europe for what it is and what it does.

To cling to capitalism and Marxism and all the other "isms" is simply to remain within European culture. There is no avoiding this basic fact. As a fact, this constitutes a choice. Understand that the choice is based on culture, not race. Understand that to choose European culture and industrialism is to choose to be my enemy. And understand that the choice is yours, not mine.

This leads me back to alddress those American Indians who are drifting through the universities, the city slums and other European institutions. If you are there to learn to resist the oppressor in accordance with your traditional ways, so be it. I don't know how you manage to combine the two, but perhaps you will succeed. But retain your sense of reality. Beware of coming to believe the white world now offers solutions to the problems it confronts us with.

Beware, too, of allowing the words of native people to be twisted to the advantage of our enemies. Europe invented the practice of turning words around on themselves. You need only look to the treaties between American Indian peoples and various European governments to know that this is true. Draw your strength from who you are.

A culture which regularly confuses revolution with continuation, which confuses science and religion, which confuses revolt with resistance, has nothing helpful to teach you and nothing to offer you as a way of life. Europeans have long since lost all touch with reality, if ever they were in touch with it. Feel sorry for them if you need to, but be comfortable with who you are as American Indians.

So, I suppose to conclude this, I should state clearly that leading anyone toward Marxism is the last thing on my mind. Marxism is as alien to my culture as capitalism and Christianity are. In fact, I can say I don't think I'm trying to lead anyone toward anything. To some extent I tried to be a "leader", in the sense that the white media like to use that term, when the American Indian Movement was a young organization. This was a result of a confusion I no longer have. You cannot be everything to everyone. I do not propose to be used in such a fashion by my enemies. I am not a leader. I am an Oglala Lakota patriot. That is all I want and all I need to be. And I am very comfortable with who I am.

I see China exploding nuclear bombs, developing uranium reactors and preparing a space program in order to colonize and exploit the planets the same as the Europeans colonized and exploited this hemisphere. It's the same old song, but maybe with a faster tempo this time.

The statement of the Soviet scientist is very interesting. Does he know what this alternative energy source will be? No, he simply has faith. Science will find a way. I hear revolutionary Marxists saying that the destruction of the environment, pollution and radiation will all be controlled. And I see them act upon their words. Do they know how these things will be controlled? No. they simply have faith. Science will find a way. Industrialization is fine and necessary. How do they know this? Faith. Science will find a way. Faith of this sort has always been known in Europe as religion. Science has become the new European religion for both capitalists and Marxists; they are truly inseparable; they are part and parcel of the same culture. So, in both theory and practice, Marxism demands that non-European peoples give up their values, their traditions, their cultural existence altogether. We will all be industrialized science addicts in a Marxist society.

addicts in a Marxist society.

I do not believe that capitalism itself is really responsible for the situation in which American Indians have been declared a national sacrifice. No, it is the European tradition; European culture itself is responsible. Marxism is just the latest continuation of this tradition, not a solution to it. To ally with the very same forces that declare us an acceptable cost.

There is another way. There is the traditional Lakota way and the ways of the other American Indian peoples. It is the way that knows that humans do not have the right to degrade Mother Earth, that there are forces beyond anything that the European mind has conceived, that humans must be in harmony with all relations or the relations will eventually eliminate the disharmony. A lopsided emphasis on humans by humans — the Europeans' arrogance of acting as though they were beyond the nature of all related things — can only result in a total disharmony and a readjustment which cuts arrogant humans down to size, gives them a taste of that reality beyond their grasp on control and restores the harmony. There is no need for a revolutionary theory to bring this about; it's beyond human control. The nature peoples of this planet know this so they do not theorize about it. Theory is an abstract; our knowledge is real.

do not theorize about it. Theory is an abstract; our knowledge is real.

Distilled to its basic terms, European faith — including the new faith in science — equals a belief that man is God. Europe has always sought a Messiah, whether that be the man Jesus Christ or the man Karl Marx or the man Albert Einstein. American Indians know this to be totally absurd. Humans are the weakest of all creatures, so weak that other creatures are willing to give up their flesh that we may live. Humans are able to survive only through the exercise of rationality since they lack the abilities of other creatures to gain food through the use of fang and claw.

But rationality is a curse since it can cause humans to forget the

But rationality is a curse since it can cause humans to forget the natural order of things in ways other creatures do not. A wolf never forgets his or her place in the natural order. American Indians can. Europeans almost always do. We pray our thanks to the deer, our rolations, for allowing us their flesh to eat; Europeans simply take the flesh for granted and consider the deer inferior. After all, Europeans consider themselves godlike in their rationalism and science. God is the Supreme Being; all else must be inferior.

All European tradition, Marxism included, has conspired to defy the natural order of all things. Mother Earth has been abused, the powers have been abused, and this cannot go on forever. No theory can alter that simple fact, Mother Earth will retaliate, the whole environment will retaliate, and the abusers will be eliminated. Things come full circle, back to where they started. That's revolution. And that's a prophecy of my people, of the Hopi people and of other correct peoples.

and of other correct peoples.

American Indians have been trying to explain this to Europeans for centuries. But, as I said earlier, Europeans have proven themselves unable to hear. The natural order will win out, and the offenders will die out, the way deer die when they offend the harmony by overpopulating a given region. It's only a matter of time until what Europeans call "a major catastrophe of global proportions" will occur. It is the role of American Indian peoples, the role of all natural beings, to survive. A part of our survival is to resist. We resist not to overthrow a government or to take political power, but because it is natural to resist extermination, to survive. We don't want power over white institutions; we want white institutions to disappear. That's revolution.

American Indians are still in touch with these realities — the

American Indians are still in touch with these realities — the prophecies, the traditions of our ancestors. We learn from the elders, from nature, from the powers. And when the catastrophe is over, we American Indian peoples will all be here to inhabit the hemisphere. I don't care if it's only a handful living in the Andes. American Indian people will survive; harmony will be established. That's revolution

At this point, perhaps, I should be very clear about another matter, one which should already be clear as a result of what I've said. But confusion breeds easily these days, so I want to hammer home this point. When I use the term European, I'm not referring to a skin color or a particular genetic structure. What I'm referring to is mind-set, a world view that is a product of the development of European culture. People are not genetically encoded to hold this outlook; they are acculturated to it. The same is true for American Indians or for the members of any culture.

It is possible for an American Indian to share European values, a European world view. We have a term for these people; we call them "apples" — red on the outside (genetics) and white on the inside (their values). Other groups have similar terms: Blacks have their "orcos"; Hispanics have "coconuts" and so on. And, as I said before, there are exceptions to the white norm: people who are white on the outside, but not white inside. I'm not sure what term should be applied to them other than "human beings"

applied to them other than "human beings".

What I'm putting out here is not a racial proposition but a cultural proposition. Those who ultimately advocate and defend the realities of European culture and its industrialisation are my enemies. Those who resist it, who struggle against it, are my allies, the allies of American Indian people. And I don't give a damn what their skin colour happens to be. Caucasian is the white term for the white race; European is an outlook I oppose.

The Vietnamese Communists are not exactly what you might consider genetic Caucasians, but they are now functioning as mental Europeans. The same holds true for Chinese Communists, for Japanese capitalists or Bantu Catholics or Peter "MacDollar" down at the Navajo Reservation or Dickie Wilson up here at Pine Ridge. There is no racism involved in this, just an acknowledgement of the mind and spirit that make up culture.

1992 marks 500 years of European domination in the Western Hemisphere, and for the Indigenous Peoples of the Rocky Mountains and Northern Plains it will be a time for total emancipation from the alien laws that have disallowed us to live as we were instructed by the Great Mystery.

We have witnessed your concept of civilization and sovereignty which allows the air, the water, Earth and yourselves to be poisoned, raped and despiritualized so that your children inherit the curse you refer to as your culture. The Earth is our government and the natural laws of the creation that we have chosen to live by and honour give us sovereignty.

This belief system has allowed our people to live sovereignty in the Western Hemisphere for at least 30,000 years.

Going back a mere 100 years to the time of your Industrial Revolution in our homelands, the Earth and our people have been victims of serious and unnecessary destruction; a destruction so great that your own scientists have announced that you must change your unnatural and unclean ways or markind will not survive another decade.

Upon your arrival in this hemisphere, our ancestors advised your forefathers how to live with the Earth, but because of greed and arrogance you find yourselves in the perilous situation that you are in today.

We cannot relate to "Canada" because it represents colonial oppression, industrial and corporate greed, and a people out of balance, living in distress and uncertainty. The origin of the word "Canada" derives from the word Kanata which, in our language, means clean. So for us to accept being Canadian is to accept not only the pollution of our language, but to include ourselves among those who have turned this beautiful country into the unclean condition it is in today. You would be well advised to listen to those concerned people among you who are offering safe and healthy alternatives to your dangerous and life threatening ways.

Our people have historically accessed the Rocky Mountains and ceased to do so only because of the imposition of your "Indian Act" and your fraudulent "Treaties" which we were forced to sign or face extermination.

The days of existing in Third World conditions created by you, and further perpetrated through your racist government policies, are over. We are aware of the water diversion conspiracy that exists between governments of Alberta, Canada and the United States of America and because of it we will begin to occupy the Rocky Mountains in the province of Alberta to protect what

We will not allow you to divert the rivers to the south because they do not belong to you and were not placed on this Earth to accommodate your schemes. These Rocky Mountains have always been and will continue to be our sacred spiritual centre, so it should be well understood by all why we will

defend them with our very lives. We will obey the laws of our Nation and stop anyone who comes in to abuse or disrupt the natural order; this natural order includes the animal nations that are an inseparable part of our world. We are not claiming ownership of these mountains because it is against our laws to own the Earth, but we are informing you that no government or corporation in this world will ever again be allowed to impose their alien mandated policies of destruction in our homeland. All people are welcome, but we will not tolerate any further desecration of our holy land.

The political terminology used to determine the status and rights of our people will no longer apply. We know who we are, and we will not permit neocolonialists to further misrepresent us by begging for recognition from you through a constitutional process which you cannot even agree upon among yourselves.

Any harassment whatsoever from any branch of your governments, directed toward our people, will be interpreted as an act of aggression and will be dealt with immediately by our Nation's defenders.

If you wish to deal with us in a court of law, we will gladly accommodate you through a world tribunal held in our territory with all the other Nations present to witness your reply to the charge of genocide.

In conclusion, we would like you to understand that we have serious concerns for our children's future and that future depends on our ability to honour the Earth by protecting the natural world of which we are a part.

For non-Indigenous peoples and governments, we invite you to learn from us for the good of your children's futures and to restore balance and sanity to

To the governments of Canada, we invite your representatives to abandon their arrogance and misconceptions of our people and begin to listen and learn from us, for we have much to offer you in ways of finding solutions to the problems you have created. We have been watching you stumble through your constitutional talks and we see clearly how secularly humanized you have become so we will, in closing, offer you some advice which to our people is a living philosophy: "A Constitution that is in harmony with the Earth will bring harmony to the people of the Earth."

MANILA — Religious cultists who said they were carrying out a divine commanc to deflate vehicle tires ran amok in the Philippine capital Monday, paralyzing traffic throughout the city. Police arrested 32 people. -

Terriñed motorists abandoned their vehicles and fled for cover as armed police chased the cultists, who swarmed through stalled traffic deflating tires. Other cultists flagged down buses and then let the air out before drivers could stop them.

"This is God's order to let out air." seid Honora Dimagila, 44, one of those arrested. "Air is from God. This is the solution to the crisis in our country."

The mass deflating, which appeared to have been well planned, began during the evening rush hour and created massive traffic jams. Hours later, traffic was still at a standstill on major thoroughfares.

It was unclear what purpose the cultists thought was served by the bizarre strategy. When pressed for an explanation, they said only that cult leader Alelio Bemaldez Pen told them it was God's will.




Minister, Students Drown Trying to Walk on Water

THE ECOLOGY OF FUCK

When the word and the idea have gone full circle, then there is no speaker, no spoken, only understanding."

The power of language and by implication the inherent power of the concepts embodied by language are by and large overlooked in modern western culture. The implications of linguistics, the how and why of where words came from and how they are used in common usage can be and is intimately tied to communication.

This past autumn I was visiting my native mountains, enjoying some of my favorite magic places when some helicopters flew overhead, WHAP, WHAP, WHAP! Fuck you! Fuck you! Fuck you!

I got hopping mad, as wilderness lovers are went to do, and start ed yelling back: Fuck you, fuck you, fuck you! Appropriate, I thought, but the cool thing is that it got me thinking about language and the word"fuck." Such a strange word seemingly packed with with violence and yet so highly eroticized. A recent study revealed that a whopping 59% of the peopled polled used the word "fuck" 'occasionally' or 'often' prior to lovemaking. Where did the word come from? What are its roots? What does it mean when we tell someone to "go get fucked!" or when in the height of passion we ask someone to "fuck me"? And what does it say about us, our words, and our cultur? You may be suprised.

Digging into language is a lot like archeological digging -- there's a treasure down there! And one of our favorite and often overused (but not misused) words is no exception. It appears that like many english words, it has more than one root meaning. Here's some suprising facts: An ancient Germanic word, no longer used, "fulche,' meant "to treat tenderly, lightly, or affectionately." An ancient phrase used in Druidic rituals, "phaaelkue; meant literally "to be enveloped from above," a spiritual/sensual concept that is thought to be derived from the commonly observed phenomena of mists and fogs enveloping the rocky peaks and highlands of the British Isles.17th and 18th century sailors, buccaneers, and pirates popularized the olde english "fucke" to "fuck," which



One can almost hear the colorful sailor of the day "(w)'e fock'd tha' fock'r in th' fo'c's'le!", certainly violent slang and yet one of the more complex and ornate knots that sailors tied to pass their long hours at sea was the "fuck'r" knot, a gentle, non-utilitarian weaving of three separate ropes that imitates a couple (woman astride) in the act of passion (see Jane's"1001 Nautical and Other Knots.")

The shrouding mists of antiquity and the passage age, not to mention the vagueness, of time often adds to the mystery of the roots of words, often uncovering more questions than answers. Linguistic

cross-pollenization of root words from Eastern to Western languages, is a fascinting study. Is it coincidence or is there a connection in the Sqnskrit word that translates phonetically, not conceptually (of course), to our "fuck," and has itself two meanings, literally "to reign blows upon," and yet strangely and conversely, "to enfold blossoms," which is occasionally used in the Kama Sutra to describe the gentlest of sexua! actions? Finally, another and not the last or least of examples; in Aramaic, which has many words and nuances of words for love, in which we read the familiar bible quote, "Love your enemy as you love yourself." The "love" in this case was closely linked, if only phonetically, to one of several Aramaic words for erotic love which literally meant "to fuck (with) me." Was Jesus hintting to us through the subtleties of word rootage that the secret of overcoming hate is intimately linked to our understanding and passions, i.e. loving/fucking our lovers/enemies? Where do We cross the line between language and spirituality? How does it apply to the language of activism? The language of education? Of ecology ("I love nature! - I think Charlie Hurwitz should fuck off!" etc.)?

Food for thought. Is it just words? So much or can understanding help us, as activists, in our approach to educate the public in a positive way, to change the world for the better? Can "fuck you!" mean "I love you!?" in the deepest sense? Language, words... do you find it simply anazing, as I do, that "gullible" isn't even in the dictionary?







A BOOK REVIEW, OF SORTS

THE ECOLOGY OF FREEDOM, Murray Bookchin, Black Rose Press. Montreal, 1991

Murray Bookchin's TUE FCOLOGY OF FPFFDOM has received considerable accolades since it was published in 1982, and is frequently cited in bibliographies of radical ecology literature. The most noteworthy aspect of the 1991 edition, however, is the new 60 page introduction, which defies the imagination.

It always amazes me that the editors at Rlack Rose Press, or periodicals like The Progressive or Pick It Over still print Rookchin's stuff uncut and in its full, jarring plory. There is nothing new here, it is essentially a word-for-word reiteration of the same personal attack on deep ecologists Bookchin has been getting reprinted worldwide at least since 1987. The book's foaming-at the-mouth ranting seems proof that the man is no longer in control of his mental faculties, if he ever was.

Strong words, you say. Well. in the gospel according to Murray, it is not so much deep ecologists and Farth First!ers who want to go "hack to the Pleistocene" who are to be bated and feared, though of course they are "misanthropic", "unfeeling", "savage", "not unlike the Nazis". "as stupid as they are dispicable", etc. etc. One also has to take into account "the proliferation of wiccan covens. goddess--worshipping congregations, assorted pantheistic and animistic cults, wilderness devotees (the worst sort of people we harhor in America today) and ecofeminist acolvtes" who, "clothed in the mystical varors and inchoate vararies of fevered imaginations", "exorcised by rituals, incantations and magical gymnastics", armed with "amulets, charms, brightly tinted garments (the horror!) speak in terms of "earth wisdom", "queasy mysticism" and "tales of talking animals", "the antics or even protests" of which 'duel with ghosts instead of institutionalized centers of nower". Let's see. did I forget to say we "think like a rock", have a "hatred for the Renaissance", and are "atavistic" to hoot? To be perfectly honest, I'm not even sure what "atavistic" means, but since Murrav uses it with such It goes on like this for some 60 pages. If there is any pattern, it

It goes on like this for some 60 pages. If there is any pattern, it seems to be one of a special hatred for women. Bookchin returns with abject horror to this problem of "the proliferation of witches" on the modern scene. One begins to wonder, like his good New England forebearers Cotton Mather and such, if Murray himself does not favor some sort of 'final solution' to this loathsome and vexing problem of "witch-covens and goddess-worshippers". Jonathan Porritt, in a courageous article in Resurgence (March/April 1988), suggests that Bookchin's endless raving against "nature worship, wood sprites, flakev spiritualists" and all really reveals A DEEP HATRED OF NATURE ITSELE, and guotes Mark Twain: "When they lost sight of their goals, they redoubled their efforts."

But enough of that, let's go on to the book itself. Aside from an occasional threat of insult directed at deep ecologists, I was surprised how closely the revised edition follows the 1082 version. There are the endless citations of Marx and Marxist theory, as if Marx were the end-all and be-all of any philosophical inquiry. One thing you can say about Bookchin, no matter how outdated or discredited his ideas become, he sticks to his guns. We gushes about "the uniqueness of human beings and the wondrous role that they can play in natural evolution,...the ability to change the world for the better and enrich it for virtually all life forms." p.IX. What life forms is Murray referring to here? Rats and lice cockroaches, starlings and pigeons? Is the earth really a 'richer' place because we have turned so much wilderness into sewage treatment plants, shopping malls, strip mines, land fills, silt-choked reservoirs and so on? Does Bookchin really imagine the council of all beings is in the process of drafting us humans a letter of commendation?

My second major objection centers around Bookchin's claim that we are poised on the threshold of a "post-scarcity abundance" society, another embarrassing phrase almost as prevalent in his writings as the word "atavistic". Apparently aware of his vulnerability on this issue, he jumps to the attack, and loudly proclaims that those who sponsor the "mystification of scarcity" mark "the first step toward ecofascism."p.72 In other words; question any detail of what I've just said and I'll call you a Mazi.

Like the Wizard of Oz. Bookchin realizes his great din and fury have not staved off the interlopers, who have glimpsed him manipulating levers behind his curtain of rhetoric. So his next tactic is to attempt to cloak himself in the most dense, inpenetrable language possible, so that only one or two living members of the Frankfurt school could understand it and maybe not them even

stand it, and maybe not them, even.

How is it that "wondrous" humanity does away with scarcity, creates "utopias of plenty". "more fecund gardens than Eden itself" p.343? Why, by "high technology". which it is now "social ecology's crucial responsibility to demystify". p.262. Not "small", "soft", or "convivial" technology, all of which Bookchin repeatedly mocks in his childish attempt to elevate his own thesis, but "high" technology.










Now get this: "For the present there can be no serious claim that any major, irreplaceable resource will be exhausted until humanity can choose new alternatives... In sum, high technology must be used by serious social ecologists to demonstrate that, on rational grounds, it is less desirable than ecological technologies. High technology must be permitted to exhaust its specious claims as the token of social progress and human well-being - all the more to render the development of ecological alternatives as a matter of choice rather than the product of cynical 'necessity'." p.262.

This strikes me as one of the most fantastically garbled statements I have ever seen anywhere. Taken at face value, there is virtually no evil such a statement could not be used to justify. Biotechnology should then he left to run riot, once the planet has been turned into a lunarscape then we sort everything out. That certainly would be "exhausting its claim", wouldn't it?

Then there are statements such as: "The need to rescue technics as a means of mediating our relationship with nature - including human nature - does not conflict with humanity's own right to intervene in the natural world, to do so even better than 'blind' nature in fostering variety and natural fecundity." p.268.

Now if we were talking about in-balance aboriginal cultures and their technologies and intervenings in the natural world. that would be one thind. But make no mistake about it. "ever-vthing is natural insofar as it exists" (p.XX), and it is "the existing technics of the western world" (p.261) that hold the promise of a post-scarcity anarchism. Nature itself is "blind perhaps even a "witch" that ought to be roughly shouldered aside. Lord Nan is in control now, the world is our drag strip, and we're going for one hell of a ride.

Loud go on with such passages, I could tell you should the messianic character of this book" (p.14), how indegenous shamanism was the harbinger of political tyranny, how con-

temporary spirituality is not unlike "the fascist appeal to blood and soil", and that Rational Fcology and Rational Ecology only is the only path toward the future. But why bother, you get the idea, and it is starting to make me physically ill.

So I close with a special appeal to Murray Bookchin, if I can interrupt for a moment his ranting and raving against the new, the creative, the spiritual, anything that does not conform to a purely Rational approach to the world. There is plenty of room in the radical ecology movement for all kinds of approaches. What there cannot be, however, is one level of consciousness applied by force from the top down. So lighten




