







# Neo-Naz: RALLY TURNS VIOLENT AFTER PROTESTERS SHOW UP

ST. PAUL, Minn. (AP) - A neo-Nazi rally turned violent Saturday as protesters threw rocks and insults at the group and took chains and poles to one of the organizer's cars.

Eleven members of the National Socialist Movement arrived for a noon rally in downtown St. Paul and were met by about 20 protesters chanting ``No Nazis, No killers.''

The protesters, who called themselves Anti-Racist Action, surrounded the neo-Nazis, spitting at them and throwing stones, while the neo-Nazis gave the fascist salute and shouted ``Sieg Heil.''

"This is not about free speech. This is about hate speech and they're very different things,'' protester Michelle Gross said.

Members of the two groups fought as the protesters chased the neo-Nazis to their cars. One of the vehicles was pelted with rocks, and protesters smashed in its hood, windows and headlights.

About 100 members of the supremacist group had planned a weekend meeting and rally in the Minneapolis suburb of Golden Valley, but called it off after a motel canceled their reservation.

Swastika-emblazoned literature mailed out by the group condemned Jews and ``coloreds,'' and advertised the event as the ``Adolf Hitler Memorial Rally.''

Two people were arrested Saturday, one from each side. A neo-Nazi was charged with aggravated assault for allegedly punching a protester in the face, knocking out his front teeth, and police said they planned to charge the injured protester with inciting to riot.

Several protesters suffered minor injuries; there was no indication how many members of the neo-Nazi group were hurt. That's the way, ARA! No platform for Nazis and fascists! But did it violate the non-violence code?


LAURENS—A man pur-posely crashed his van Sunday through the front windows of a store selling Confederate and Ku Klux Klan paraphernalia, police said.

Police say David Prichard Hunter backed his van in and' out of The Redneck Shop. Hunter, who is white, then climbed on top of the van, grabbed a stick and started beating the marquee sign say-ing "The World's Only Klan Museum." Museum.

No one was inside the store at the time. Hunter, 43, of West Columbia. was charged with malicious damage to property.

Hunter was angry about the existence of The Reducck Shop and had vowed "to do some-thing about it," said his brother, Kevin Hunter,

## \* UNITED GOLORS of GLOBAL ACTION \*

There's a woman from the Peruvian guerrilla group Tupac Amaru chatting to a Russian environmentalist. Nearby, ac-tivists from the Brazilian land squatters movement are doing some funky moves on the dance floor with a guy from the union. Then some Brits brashly challenge Filipino se afarers' a bunch of Maori indigenous people activists to a drinking contest. To where on earth have all these people come? This is Geneva; city of Rousseau, banking, and the U. N.

But alongside the city's international stature as the capital of capital', there exists the lesser-known reality of a place with more squatted social centres than probably any other European city. And now many of these have becom enues for the first People's Global Action conference, for which grassroots activists from over half the nations of the world are trickling together; a confluence of radical cur-rents taking place where Geneva nestles between the moun-

Attending the gathering is like a political shot in the arm. So maybe just because half the world's radical move-ments are clinking beer glasses here, doesn't mean that tomorrow afternoon will see the downfall of global capitalism. But the breathtaking diversity of folks here are all awakening to each other's struggles, and sizing up their common globalised enemy with a fast sharpening sense of purpose. Beneath the flaming Spanish guitar and ethnic drumming of the evening's entertainment, its possible to hear the tanta-

We were all fingers, now we're going to make a fist", enthuses Olivio, one of the organisers of the gathering. The 400 or so participants are taking forward the same process of determined international networking that was going on at the Zapatista-inspired Encuentro (`encounter') in Spain last summer, where the idea for the People's Global Action was born. This time, the focus is clearly defined: action against the World Trade Organisation as it celebrates is 50th anniversary in May. In Geneva we are lathering up our collective forearm; the UN's institutional lackey of global capital is about to receive a global grassroots fisting.

On Wednesday in Geneva 500 people marched in carniva-lesque style to the headquarters of the WTO, blocking major roads. The effervescent mixture of some of the world's most marginalised peoples came directly to the heart of the beast - the very building from whose corridors a handful of suits quietly plot the onset of world corporate domination. Activists blockaded the car exit and scaled pillars, drop-ping anti-free trade banners over WTO's gateway. A handful of checky activists sneaked into the building, eventually being chucked out after bringing up their concerns with people inside.

by Peoples' Global Action Today the Second Ministerial Conference of the World Trade Organization (WTO) starts in Geneva, in the context of a hundreds of protests all over the World.

a hundreds of protests all over the World. Nearly a million of people from all social sectors (farmers, indigenous peoples, workers, women, ethnical groups, unemployed and many other groups) are expressing since the 1st of May our rejection to the WTO, the multilat-eral trade system, and neoliberal policies - participating in the first international days of action of Peoples' Global Action (PGA) against "Free" Trade and the WTO.

On Saturday, at the same time as the beginning of the G8 Summit, over hundred thousand people throughout the world protested against the WTO and their neoliberal policies:

Global Street Parties were celebrated in 35 cities all over the world, for example in Geneva, Birmingham, Sydney, Toronto and Prague with several thousand people in each town.

In Brazil, a protest march of 40 000 landless and home less people reached the capital Brasilia; 10 000 unemployed joined them on Monday. On Wednesday, the final day of the WTO conference, a demonstration through the government district of Brasilia is planned.

In Canada, a protest against the planned Multilateral Agreement on Investment (MAI) is scheduled for today. There will be further demonstrations and direct actions in different Canadian cities on Wednesday.

The OECD meeting starting this weekend in Montreal shall

Peoples Global Action is a worldwide alliance of organi-zations and grassroots movements that was formed the last February in a conference where representatives of grassroots movements from 56 countries of all continents came together. The conference produced the Manifesto of the PGA "We live in a time in which capital, with the help of international agencies like the World Trade Organisation (WTO), the International Monetary Fund (IMF), the World Bank (WB) and other institutions, is shaping national policies in order to strengthen its global control over political, economic and cultural life.

Capital has always been global. Its boundless drive for expansion, and profit recognises no limits. From the slave trade of earlier centuries to the imperial colonisation of peoples, lands and cultures across the globe, capitalist ac-cumulation has always fed on the blood and tears of the peoples of the world. This destruction and misery has been restrained only by grassroots resistance.

Today, capital is deploying a new strategy to assert its power and neutralise peoples' resistance. Its name is eco-nomic globalisation, and it consists in the dismantling of national limitations to trade and to the free movement of capital.

The effects of economic globalisation spread through the munities of the world, integrat. fabric of societies and com ing their peoples into a single gigantic system aimed at the Words like "globalisation", "liberalisation" and "deregulation" just disguise the growing disparities in living condi-tions between elites and masses in both privileged and "petion" ripheral" countries.

Land, water, forest, wildlife, aquatic life and mineral resources are not commodities, but our life support. For decades the powers that have emerged from money and market have swelled their profits and tightened their control of politics and economics by usurping these resources, at the cost of the lives and livelihoods of vast majorities around the world. For decades the World Bank and the IMF, and now the WTO, in alliance with national governments and corporate powers, have facilitated maneuverings to appropriate the environment. The result is environmental devastation, tragic and unmanageable social displacement, and the wiping out of cultural and biological diversity, much of it irretrievably lost without compensation to those reliant on it.

The WTO, the IMF, the World Bank, and other institutions that promote globalisation and liberalisation want us to believe in the beneficial effects of global competition. Their agreements and policies constitute direct violations of basic human rights (including civil, political, economic, so-cial, labour and cultural rights) which are codified in incernational law and many national constitutions, and in-

grained in people's understandings of human dignity. We have had enough of their inhuman policies. We reject the principle of competitiveness as solution for peoples' problems. It only leads to the destruction of small producers and local economies. Neo-liberalism is the real enemy of economic freedom.

The need has become urgent for concerted action to dismantle the illegitimate world governing system which bines transnational capital, nation-states, international financial institutions and trade agreements.

Only a global alliance of peoples' movements, respecting autonomy and facilitating action-oriented resistance, can defeat this emerging globalised monster. If impoverishment of populations is the agenda of neo-liberalism, direct empowerment of the peoples though constructive direct action and civil disobedience will be the programme of the Peoples' Global Action against "Free" Trade and the WTO."

In a press briefing that took place today at United Nations the representatives of PGA declared: "The struggle that takes place in these days will continue until the disappearance of the WTO and all other institutions and agreements that cause misery and death. It is part of a process of convergence of millions of people fighting all over the planet for a just society in harmony with the environment. The movements that participate in this process want to send a clear message to the WTO: we will not allow economic globalisation to destroy our environment, our culture, our fu-ture, our lives. Consequently, we reject the treaties of the WTO and we will not allow their implementation".

PRAGUE, Czech Republic (AP) Nine young people have been charged with hooliganism after an environmental protest in Prague ended in looting and clashes with police, officials said today.

Police with batons broke up a crowd of 2,000 stone-throwing youths Saturday after a peaceful protest on the impact that multinational corporations have on the environment turned violent. Twenty-two police officers were injured in the melee.

The mob overturned a police car, looted several shops and damaged two fast-food restaurants. Police initially detained 64 people, but released most of them Sunday.

A judge ruled today the nine young people, who were charged with hooliganism and attacking public officials, would remain in custody during the investigation, police spokeswoman Eva Brozova said. They face up to three years in prison if convicted.


The Czech Movement for Civic Solidarity and Tolerance, HOST, said police broke the law by violently breaking up the demonstration and denying detainees the use of toilets and water, the CTK news agency reported.

Some environmental organizations, including the Czech branch of Greenpeace, condemned the violent protest.

The Czechoslovak Anarchist Federation, the U.S.-based radical environmental group Earth First, and the Moscow-based Rainbow Keepers were among those organizing the demonstration.



Even the mighty capitalist titan has its Achilles' heel - the high-seas. The corporate giants can't walk on water nor can they fly large cargo containers corporate glants can't walk on water nor can they fly large cargo containers across the continents. The only economically feasible way to transport goods for the global marketplace is on the ocean. Cargo has to be on- and off-loaded by longshore workers. Fortunately, some of the most radical unions work a large number of the world's major ports. Longshore & maritime workers have played a key role in the battles against Fascism in Europe, Apartheid in South Africa, against the U.S. Timber Industry, and the U.S.'s war on Native Americans. The growing forces of corporate domination recognize that they must eliminate radical labor in order to consolidate their power fully. Multi-national companies are

labor in order to consolidate their power fully. Multi-national companies are mounting a coordinated, multi-national attack against the organized maritime workers, with the help of various governments' legislators. Using phrases like "privatization" and "increasing efficiency" to spearhead their attacks, the collusion between Capital and State has destroyed unions and killed workers under Thatcher's Britain and Howard's Australia. In Fall 1997, the Industrial Workers' of the World (IWW) played a

major part in the now world-renowned picket line that kept the Neptune Jade from unloading in the Port of Oakland, or anywhere else. The Neptune Jade was loaded by scab labor in Thamesport, England, by the governmentsupported Mersey Dock & Harbour, the company infamous for firing 500 union dockers in Liverpool. That vessel then left for ports in Canada and Japan, and never was able to get the containers unloaded. The Neptune Jade was finally sold a few months later in Taiwan with the scab cargo still on it. Since then, the Neptune Jade Defense Committee has formed in

response to a frivolous and vindictive lawsuit against picketers who ran the Neptune Jade out of the San Francisco Bay. The suit was filed by the Pacific Maritime Association - the West Coast alliance of ship owners and stevedoring companies. Among the defendants in the case - victims of a McCarthy style "witch hunt" against labor's right to free speech and assembly, to picket, and to honor picket lines - were several Wobblies(IWW), Inland Boat Union(IBU) members and union longshore workers(ILWU), including Picket Captain Robert Irminger.

On April 7, 1998, the Australian company Patrick Stevedores fired all 1,400 of its longshore employees. The company's goons - ex-military mercenaries complete with attack dogs - conducted violent, midnight raids to clear members of the Maritime Union of Australia(MUA) off the docks. 400 scabs were then airlifted into the maritime terminals around the country. The Aussie press dubbed the strike that followed the "War On The Waterfront". Mass picket lines supported by the entire labor movement kept cargo from being loaded or unloaded in most ports across the continent.

The militancy of the Aussie working class paid off. On Friday, May 8, the dispute was tentatively settled, after the High Court of Australia ruled the lockout illegal and ordered all the dockers reinstated. Workers fighting for their union's survival seemed to have decisively beaten back an attempt

by the bosses and the right-wing government to smash their organization. However, despite happy appearances, the struggle is far from over. The security goons who invaded the docks and attacked workers are still inside Patrick's terminals. Using financial sleight-of-hand to evade the Court's order, Patrick illegally siphoned off its operating capital. The company is now claiming a dire financial situation, and that it cannot afford to rehire all the longshore workers. The union leadership has unfortunately sent workers back to work on a port by port basis. Patrick workers in two major Australian ports, Newcastle and Port Adelaide, are still not on the job.

Patrick Stevedores is defying the order of Australia's Supreme Court: to rehire ALL locked-out MUA members. The company is insisting on its "right" to pick and choose which longshore workers will get their jobs back. At least 30 workers are being blackballed by Patrick because of

jobs back. At least 30 workers are being blackballed by Patrick because of their militant activities on the picket lines. And so, in early May of '98 the Columbus Canada was stopped at the docks of Terminal Island in the Port of Los Angles-Long Beach by a picket line of 1,500, organized by a coalition of labor and community groups. The ship's containers of beef sat in the port for 2 weeks before being returned to Australia. Since then, the growing reputation of solidarity actions has forced every Australian scab-loaded ship to discharge its cargo before reaching the West Coast of the Americas.

Another solidarity action took place in Portland, Oregon on June 13, 1998, in support of the striking workers at Hundai's Han Young factory in Mexico. 50 picketers in Portland assembled a picket line when a ship carrying Hundai automobiles docked. Longshore workers refused to cross the line, so the cars were not unloaded. There was one attempted arrest, which was reconsidered by the police after both the picketers and dockers strenuously objected.

These actions are part of the world-wide labor movement. The radical waterfront unions are at the forefront, but this culture of solidarity against corporate domination has been reaching every industry. If Capital no longer has boarders than Labor and solidarity shouldn't either. Direct action will win!

OSLO, Norway — A school of her-ring caught in a trawler's net refused to give up without a fight — and sank a 19-metre boat.


The trawler Steinholm was fishing off Norway's northern coast when it

made a huge catch of the fish. When the crew tried to haul in the net, the entire school of herring swam for the bottom and capsized the ship, the Oslo newspaper Dagbladet reported yesterday.

"I have been fishing since I was 14 and I have never seen anything like it," skipper Geir Nikolaisen, 49. was quoted as saying. Crew members tried to cut loose the

net but were forced to abandon the capsized ship, which sank in 10 minutes.

No one was hurt, and the six fishermen were rescued by another trawler. It was not clear whether the fish escaped the net.

## FREMONT: New Bombs Found in Exclusive Neighborhood

Devices found in 2 homes in in 2 homes in exclusive area

The city of Fremont was on edge last night after police detonated a pipe bomb found in a home under construction — a day after a house around the corner vas bombed and someone planted firebombs at the homes of the police chief and his predecessor.

Authorities evacuated an ex-clusive hillside neighborhood last night after finding the pipe bomb in the crawl space of a house on Vista del Sol. It was the same type of bomb as the two devices found in the house on nearby Corte del Sol after an explosion Sunday night, investigators said.

That bombing came the same day a firebomb exploded at the home of Police Chief Craig Steckler, and another was found at the home of Councilman Robert Wasserman, the former police chief.

"Initially, we didn't think there was a correlation (between the pipe bombs and the firebombs), but we're not ruling out the possi-

Investigators searching the neighborhood after the explosion on Corte del Sol found the latest pipe bomb yesterday afternoon in a crawl space, said Charlie Barnett, arson and bomb supervisor for the ATF office in San Francisco. Authorities also reported receiving an anonymous tip.

The bomb exploded as police tried to disarm it remotely.

The house is just up the hill through the two-story house on Corte del Sol about 8 p.m. Sunday, tearing two large holes in the floor. The two pipe bombs there also had been planted in a crawl space, Barnett said.

The only person home at the time, a 17-year-old girl, was unin-jured.

Barnett said both the devices in both houses were pipe bombs with flammable mixtures. He added that it would have been difficult to plant them without being able to get inside the houses.

The owner of the house on Vista del Sol, who did not want to be identified, said he had no idea who would have bombed the house but

Investigators were still trying to determine a motive for the first major crime against a Bay Area po-lice chief since the assassination of Union City's top cop in 1974.

Among the possibilities is that a Among the possibilities is that a citizen or a former police officer had a grudge against Steckler and Wasserman and targeted them af-ter obtaining their home addresses, police said.

Another scenario was that someone was "trying to seek ven-geance on the Police Department for some type of arrest or police action," said Fremont police Captain Mike Lanam.

"It hits home very closely, Lanam said. "Somebody's trying to make a statement against past and present police leaders and causing harm to their families."

The two firebombs were rela-tively sophisticated "improvised incendiary devices" containing flammable liquid and armed with electrical timers, police said.

The 4:16 a.m. firebomb at Steckler's south Fremont home burned a 10-foot hole in the roof and damaged his porch and front doors A neighbor who heard the explosion helped douse the flames.

Steckler and his wife of 30 years, Karen, were asleep at the time and were unhurt. The case is being treated as an attempted murder.

"Whoever did this crossed the line of civility and into stupidity," Samuels said

It is unclear how the bomber or bombers found out where Steckler and Wasserman live. Like most police. Steckler's home address is unlisted, as is Wasserman's. In mo cases, license plate checks of offi-cers' personal vehicles won't show an address, even if run through a computer by another cop.

Lanam said the incidents un-derscore the difficulties many officers face trying to maintain their safety while off-duty, especially in an age where personal data can of-ten retrieved by anyone with access to the Internet.

"I think nowadays it can be done fairly easily," Lanam said. "It doesn't take much to find out where somebody else lives."

The only other unusual inci-dent against a top Fremont official in recent years involved an arson fire that caused \$5,000 in damage to Morrison's home in February 1992, the day before a recall elec-

"We never figured out what happened," Morrison said yesterday. "In my personal opinion, somebody wanted to send a message.

No one has been injured in any of the cases. But police said the damage to Steckler's home and the Corte del Sol blast were grim reminders that it could have been far worse

"We're baffled by this whole thing and a little bit unnerved," Fremont Police Lieutenant said Gus Arroyo.

Even before last night, the city had taken extraordinary safety measures. Steckler and Wasserman are being guarded 24 hours a day, as are the homes of the city's five council members, including Mayor Gus Morrison. The FBI and the federal Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms were called in.

Police said those bombs were similar in design and construction. FBI laboratory technicians in Washington, D.C., have been called in on the case.

"Our lab is going to be handling "Our lab is going to be nanoling the evidence," FBI spokesman George Grotz said. "Because it's a multiple bombing, we'll be able to make a distinction as to whether it's similar to anything else."

Wasserman, who served as Fre

mont police chief from 1976 to 1992, saw the bomb in a brown pa per bag on the walkway leading to his front door about 1:40 p.m. Sunday. Bomb squad experts blasted the device with water to disarm it.

Wasserman said that he spoke with Steckler at some length yes terday and that nothing obvious stood out as to why they would be targeted.

"(Sunday) my concern was, 'Get angry," Wasserman said.

Bomb attacks against law forcement officials are rare, FBI figures show.

Of 2.577 bomb-related incidents or 2,5/1 bomb-related incidents in reported in the United States in 1995, just 30 were aimed at federal, state or local law enforcement or judiciary members. Of those 30, only nine involved incendiary bombs targeting local or state officials.

## conference hall, Clinton, Blair and the global summit team are dancing away to "All you need is love". By Monday the G8 globalisation tour has moved to the Palais des Nations in Geneva for World Trade Day to pay their respects to the great dollar of capitalism. Meanwhile, out on the street, hundreds of protesters are being arrested better and de hundreds of protesters are being arrested, beaten and de-ported by the Genevan authorities. And that's just for starters. Here's the SchNEWS guide to reclaiming the world...

As Clinton, Castro, Mandela and Blair flew out of Geneva this week, they left a city in shock after the worst riots seen here since 1932.

For four days this small city was under siege as the leaders of the 132-nation World Trade Organisation (WTO) met for their 50th anniversary at the United Nations building. The opposition was led by People's Global Action rejecting the whole process of globalisation and corporate power that world government.

Even before the Ministers had stepped off the planes, the city had erupted. Five thousand people came to Saturday's Street Party, and by midnight it had turned into a full scale riot. One car was set alight and thousands of police charged the main encampment, firing tear-gas into the crowd. The demonstrators smashed hundreds of windows, mainly banks and corporate offices, until 5am causing over half a million pounds damage.

Genevans awoke as one on Sunday to a tense atmosphere of confusion, and a city resembling a warzone. On pavements, phone boxes and walls the graffiti message was clear: "WTO ASSASSIN"... "WTO vs THE PEOPLE"... "REVOLUTION '98".

From the moment the world leaders sat down on Monday morning to the conclusion on Wednesday evening the streets were filled with riot police and demonstrators, with the

MONDAY: The offices of Lockheed, multinational arms traders, were occupied by one group, while another sponta-neous street demo stopped traffic and set off smoke bombs. By lunchtime the United Bank of Switzerland was forced to close and police kept back while road after road was blockaded. The group continued up to the UN building, surrounded by armed police, chanting in French, Spanish and English. By nightfall there was a highly-charged stand-off as a party kicked off next to the University.

TUESDAY: Activists from Colombia, India, South Korea, Mexico, Nicaragua, Argentina, Aotearoa/NZ and across Europe, continued a frenzy of meetings under the banner of People's Global Action, networking and organising direct action. In a deliberate display of non-violence, hundreds marched gagged and bound through town, symbolising the global muting of human rights. At the Rousseau statue, they enacted a burial of his "social contract" between people and rulers. Meanwhile the director of the WTO, Renato Ruggiero, told the confer-ence that everyone must pedal faster towards globalisation, or face the danger of falling off. (His Mercedes was later overturned).

Then, as darkness descended, so did the people. A crowd of around 500, many "L'Hiphop", kids from nearby council es-tates, confronted police at Plain Palais, systematically trashing the nearby McDonald's and Pizza Hut. The police fired CS gas to disperse the angry mass, who began to smash more shops, overturn cars and run through the city in small groups, causing chaos. Plainclothes police on mopeus gave chase. At 2am they surrounded Artamis, a huge squatted al-


ternative Centre, and arrested everyone. Since Monday the total detained stood at 287. As SchNEWS went to press over 100 people were still being held in prison.

WEDNESDAY: Hundreds assembled outside the UN for a final push - an attempt to enter the building and stop the General Assembly using Gandhi-style tactics. As they walked headlong into the line of riot police, there was a blur of truncheons and the ambulances began to arrive. According to staff at the hospital over 60 people a day have been treated, some requiring major operations. The squatters are organising demonstrations analyse buttality tomorrow (Saturdaw) monstrations against police brutality tomorrow (Saturday), and the inhumane treatment of those arrested: strip-searches, lack of medical assistance, and psychological

stress. The conference is over, and for now Geneva is quiet. "This is without doubt a popular uprising against the issue of globalisation," one activist told SchNEWS. "Not just in Geneva but in cities all over the world people are beginning to realise the consequences of this crazy process and the importance of resisting by any means necessary.

The next meeting of People's Global Action will take place from April 1st 1999 in Bangalore, India.

Residents of impoverished Ov-5 ertown generally responded with a good laugh.


"Nobody's going to tell them," said Debbie, a resident of Overtown who, like most, would only give her first name when police came knocking on Thursday

The thousands of dollars in coins, bills and food stamps rained down on the street Wednesday morning when an armored Brinks E truck carrying \$3.7 million overturned on an Interstate 95 over-

People swarmed over the area. digging money out of the dirt and and scooping it off the street, stuffing bags, boxes and pockets before police finally took charge. An estimated \$500,000 vanished.

Thursday, young men with metal detectors combed a trash-stre 



Nobody did. The suggestion that people in Overtown should give back the money brought merry laughter from residents.

Some people took the money into a nearby Republic National Bank on Wednesday and asked for coin wrappers or simply got dollar bills in exchange for the coins.

"They were bringing the money in bags and in their shirts," Michelle Barrett, who works at Republic, said Thursday. "They brought in an average of \$200 apiece."

Meanwhile, the Brinks driver, Walter Cravero, was charged with careless driving and operating improper equipment because the

truck had three bald tires. After the grace period expires, police plan to seek television news videotape to aid them in identify-

ing the money grabbers. People may not realize the seriousness of taking the money, said police spokesman Lt. Bill Schwartz. Those caught with the cash after the grace period could face grand theft charges if they have more than \$1,000.

Meanwhile the establishment press continues to enthusiastically advocate and support all manner of military and other governmental violence, and the ever growing plunder of our lives and our environment by ruthless Corporations.

There are many parallels with the McLibel case .... It is vital that all progressive groups and papers report examples of direct action by the public against companies and governmental bodies which are the cause of the problems we face today. It's these problems of injustice, oppression, exploitation and environmental damage that are a constant incitement to everyone to get organised, to create resistance and to take direct action for a better world.

We pledge to throw our weight behind the campaign to defend the right to report news of direct actions, and to free the editors of Green Anarchist. This is a campaign that can and must be won.

High Court Appeal Judge, Mr Justice Smedley, shocked a court on Friday by signing papers for

the immediate release of the Gandalf 3-- effectively undermining the original ruling - just four months into their three year sentence.

At lunchtime on Friday Saxon Wood, Noel Molland & Steve Booth were told they could pack their bags and were free to go. Their lawyers had simply put in a standard bail application to push for a (still unknown) appeal date.

The journalists, branded 'terrorists', had been jailed for reporting the facts of direct action protests. Although the three maintain they didn't even know each other, they were found guilty of "conspiring to incite persons unknown" on unspecified dates over a five year period to commit unspecified criminal damage. Hello, Orwell?

This clear case of denial of free speech was not lost on Index on Censorship which reprints samples of the 'offending' copy, from the radical journal Green Anarchist (GA) and the Animal

Liberation Front (ALF) supporters newsletter.

The move has led to hope that their convictions may be quashed, but that will have to wait for the appeal, and even possibel retrial. In the meantime, the trial on the same charges of the main target Robin Webb (ALF's press officer) with possibly Paul Rogers - is going ahead, starting on 27th April at Portsmouth Crown Court. The whole saga has so far cost the taxpayer over #4 million!




Invariably these coordinators will not have to experience your problems on a day-to-day basis. Although they will sympathise with you, they will have no idea of your suffering.

But if an organisation asks for money and stresses they you can't speak out without their permission, ignore them because it will damage your fight.

The last thing a company wants i its direct neighbours highlighting the factory's problems. It is bad for P.R., but at least they will try harder to stop you complaining. If you can't speak to the press or demonstrate at their gates, believe me, they will laugh at you.

A resident in the 5200 block of Griffen House Court received an unpleasant surprise last week when his apartment was wrecked by a lost deer.


Witnesses told police they saw a deer jump through the front window of the apartment at 6 p.m. March 3. The deer ran through the



# Animal Rights & Revolution

The recognition of animal rights--that is the "right" of nonhuman animals to live free from human oppression--is a necessity to a truly revolutionary ideology. It should be obvious by now that any revolution which fails to address the complicity of its participants in authoritarianism and oppression is doomed to the tired historical pattern of the failed revolution: replacing one set of masters for another with little change in the overall system of oppression. The hierarchy of class isn't the only one which needs to be challenged and eliminated. Radical analysis must extend to all patterns of domination, whether by race, sex, sexual orientation, or species. There are approximately 300 million species of life upon this planet (not to mention the possibility of life outside this planet). To presume our superiority over 299,999,999 other species seems at the least to be total arrogance. Perhaps this arrogance is merely leftover baggage of authoritarian, anthropocentric (humancentered), misogynistic, and outdated religious institutions? Surely this must be the case; any other line in the sand which we think of to seperate our species from all the rest, such as language, culture, or technology, can be found within the societies of various animal nations. In Animal Liberation, Peter Singer proves that there is no solid determinant which guarantees us the ability to put the desires, or the rights of our own species above that of others. In other works, a belief in the innate superiority of

humanity over other animals is speciesm. Recognizing this, animal liberation is as valid and as necessary as the liberation of humanity. Am I suggesting that everyone stop their current work on social and environmental issues? Of course not. I am merely suggesting that greater respect. is due to those radicals who choose to focus their energy upon animal issues. It may be said by some that animal rights "can wait until after the revolution". However, the elimination of the suffering of any being --right now--is valid. Also, the assault of humanity upon the wild is driving huge numbers of species to extinction. In North America, the grizzly bear once ranged from southern Alaska to Mexico, east to the Mississippi river. After 500 years of European occupation, the griz's range is at best a tenth of its former domain. The status of bison is even worse. Once numbering in the hundreds of thousands across the plains, there is now only one viable herd left in the lower 48 states. This herd of only a couple of thousand animals lives in Yellowstone park and each winter those animals who leave the confines of the park are shot at the request of cattle ranchers. Globally, all species of tiger, elephants and rhinocerous are probably going to be extinct in the wild within my lifetime. Five of seven species of bear are endangered. It is facts such as these which indicate that the issue of animal rights will not wait until "after the revolution". Whether or not you believe it worth your time to work upon animal issues, please recognize that they address a very legitimate abuse of power, and are not secondary to the revolution, but necessary to it.




and Diet For a New America by John Robbins. To finish, I'll mention another reason why animal rights activists deserve the respect and support of other radicals: the A.L.F. Even if you disagree with their means, hell, even if you disagree with their ends, they are causing more financial damage to large corporations than anyone else out there. Perhaps that is why the state always seems to treat animal rights activists more harshly than they do social or environmental activists, even based upon the commission of similar "crimes". Alternately, perhaps the treatment is due to the fact that animal rights activists challenge a far deeper falsehood perpetuated by this system: human superiority.

At the very least, oppression and hierarchy must be confronted in the life of each person who thinks themselves "revolutionary". Thus, veganism becomes a necessity in our society of factory farms and industrial agri-business. Even if you do not agree with anything I've said so far, the most basic research into the environmental and social impacts of a meat-based diet would tend towards this conclusion. Even if you totally rule out the brutalities being inflicted on the thousands upon thousands of animals living in factory farms and being slaughtered for your taste buds, the amount of resources--water, power, grains-which make animal products so inefficient a food to produce should drive any social activist to veganism. In fact, "with the amount of food, water and labor used to produce meat, you could feed all of the hungry

For years, there has been a concerted effort on the part of the government and the mainstream media to treat the Animal Rights and Environmental movements as seperate movements. This FALSE division has been perpetuated by singleissue sectarians in the Animal Rights Movement and insecure meat eaters within the Environmental movement who fear a philosophy (Animal Liberation) which is morally and politically consistant, unlike "Deep Ecology". The tragedy of this is that the Animal Liberation Movement and the Environmental Movement are natural allies and too much time is wasted bickering amongst ourselves instead of uniting against our common enemy, capitalist-industrial society. Both movements are complimentary forces (often made up of the same people) in the same struggle against the same system of domination that enslaves animals and destroys the earth and it's imperative that we begin to publically and financially support each other through networking and unified, active resisitance. Animal Rights and Environmentalism ultimately lead to the same conclusion about this Death Culture we live in and its complete lack of respect for life. A sincere concern for animals and wildlife will eventually become a concern for habitat, which will become a concern for ecosystem health. A love for the wolf and other large predators will eventually force all who are honest enough to question the meat-based diet, modern agribusiness, the politics of food distribution and speciesism itself.

Biocentrism, the philosophy many EARTH FIRSTERS! subscribe to, is the belief that all forms of life have intrinsic and equal worth and is essentially a rejection of the human-centered, speciesist worldview. So why do so many Animal Rights activist and Environmentalists appear to be working so hard to maintain this silly seperation? Wouldn't our energy be better spent educating each other, sharing information and building solidarity?

The answers to these questions are complex, but as a participant in both movements I feel qualified to make some general observations and offer some suggestions on how we can begin to coordinate our attacks on the enemy and move beyond our supposed differences. I'll try to make my point as quickly as possible so that we can move on to cover the actions that militant eco-vegan warriors have been taking in recent months against the timber industry, which is hopefully the beginning of a pro-Earth, pro-Animal Revolutionary Movement in the United States.

I'm taking time out to address these issues not because I want to waste paper in long-winded rhetoric, but because I care deeply about the Earth and the Animal Nations and recognize the urgent need for we, as a movement, to get serious about what we're doing. So let's briefly examine some of the false perceptions and antagonistic attitudes the Animal Rights Movement and the Environmental Movement have toward each other and then discuss what we have to learn from each other and what needs to happen to make both movements a real threat to the Death Industries.

Struggle, One

LF and ELF, Together At

The main problem, as I see it, is that there are conservative, old-guard elements within both movements that are resisting unification because they fear change and they fear what they cannot control. The reality is that there are thousands of conscious, well-educated and angry youth who see the obvious connections between Animal Rights and Environmentalism and who are coming together with their own ideas about who their enemies are and what tactics are effective in putting them out of business. Empowered and pissed off youth are flooding the ranks of both movements and helping to revitalize them with their dedication and their commitment. This frightens the main-streamers and the "professional" PAID activists who realize that this struggle is very real to these young people, that they are fighting an all-out war for planetary survival, that most of them have given up on reformist half-measures and are instead speaking in terms of REVOLUTION. There is no stopping this wave of energy and it's inevitable that the old guard and their ideas will be swept aside by this new breed of activist, who are sick of holding signs and writing letters.

The other factor that creates hostility between the Animal Rights and Environmental Movement is the sometimes arrogant and dogmatic way that come vegetarians push their beliefs on other; the Animal Rights Movement has been rightfully criticized for being too philosophical and too bourgeois, narrowly focused on diet and moral absolutes without giving much thought to the plastic vegan packaging or the sick consumer culture that produced it. Many rural environmentalists--who have a more direct relationship with the planet they are defending than city dwellers--see veganism as an extremely abstract, puritanical ideal and are more concerned with growing their own food and with sustainable living, than in getting into debates about nonvegan footwear. If Animal Rights activists want

to form alliances with Native Americans, for the instance, they will have to develop a respect for cultural diversity (without, of course, CON-DONING animal abuse and learn to EDUCATE others, rather than judge or condemn them.

There are many other philosophical and lifestyle differences that will have to be overcome (or ignored) as we work to build a movement capable of smashing at the foundations of animal and earth abuse, but the important thing for now is that we follow the example of groups like the Animal Liberation Front (A.L.F.) and TAKE ACTION. Economic sabotage is the only thing the earth raping, animal abusing scum will respond to, so let's study how the successful groups (like the A.L.F.) get away with it and apply that knowledge to targets of our own choosing.



## VISUALIZE BURNING POLICE CARS



The Japan Times Wednesday, June 3, 1998 CHIBA (Kyodo) - Two early morning explosions at a bus depot in Matsudo, Chiba Prefecture, gutted two buses used on Narita airport routes and damaged a third bus Tuesday. No injuries were reported. Police sources put blame bus

for the blasts on radical opponents of the interna-tional airport.

The explosions occurred in the bus depot at the Matsudo office of Keisei Electric Railway's motor ve-hicle department at around 3:30 a.m.

3130 a.m. The blast set three of four buses parked in the de-pot on fire, police said. The buses belong to Keisei and its affiliate, Narita Airport Transport Service, which operates bus service to Narita airport. Lead cables and batteries

Lead cables and batteries were found near the rear tires of the destroyed buses, prompting police to speculate the detonating devices were prepared by radi-cal opponents to the air-



tudents at Susan B. Anthony Elementary School were greeted Thursday morning by campus walls covered with blue scrawls advocating the death of police officers, officials said. Late Wednesday or early

Thursday, vandals sprayed graffiti on a wing of classrooms, the administration building and two adjoining rooms.

The scrawls on the Detroit Boulevard school in the Meadowview area said "All cops must die," "Kill a cop" and "Kill all police," according to Vince Matranga, chief of the Sacra-mento City Unified School Dis-trict Delive Destination of the Sacratrict Police Department.

Matranga said the vandalism was especially worrisome be-cause some of the graffiti tar-geted a specific officer by badge number.

That number belongs to a neighborhood police officer who made several gang and drug arrests in the area surrounding the elementary school.

"In my 22 years at the school district, I've never seen graffiti like this before," he said. "When anyone threatens a police officer, or names that police officer by badge number, we take that very seriously."

Police have no suspects but think juveniles, possibly gang members, are responsible.

S.F. Cop Knocked Out

**Teeth Kept as Trophies** 

A routine arrest turned into a bloody struggle yesterday after a man stepped from a crowd of angry onlookers and whacked a San Francisco police officer with a plank of wood, knocking him unconscious and knocking out several teeth.

Officer Jason Jefferson, 25, was brought to San Francisco General Hospital and was released last night.

Police said Jefferson and his partner, Peter Walsh, were arresting a man for reckless driving in the 1800 block of Sunnydale Avenue when a small crowd gathered.

"The suspect was resisting ar-rest," Walsh said. "The crowd grew hostile, and my partner was hit with a rock or a brick. The suspect was kicking me."

Walsh said the suspect, identified only by his last name of Frierson, was continuing to resist arrest while in handcuffs and that people

in the crowd were trying to free him from the officers' custody. Walsh said the suspect was spray-ed in the face with the officer's chemical weapon while in custody. "The crowd was very hostile.

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 11, 1995

We were two white officers in a predominantly black neighbor-hood," Walsh said.

Police Lieutenant Bill Gilbert said the weapon that struck Jefferson was not a rock or brick but a 2-by-4-inch plank of wood.

"The guy came up behind the officer and hit him in the mouth," Gilbert said. "Then the crowd took the teeth as trophies.'

Another officer said people in the crowd threw golf balls at Jefferson and Walsh.

Ikie Walker, a neighborhood resident who watched the strug-gle, said the crowd became angry because the officers sprayed a man already under restraint. "He was handcuffed and up against the car, and the policeman went right up to his face and sprayed him up close," Walker said.

More than a dozen officers searched the neighborhood for the man who hit Jefferson. One man, who was driven from the scene in an unmarked police car with four plainclothes officers, was being "detained for questioning" but not under arrest, Gilbert said.

A police dispatcher said last night that Deputy Chief Thomas Petrini issued a memo sent by teletype to all district stations, reminding police to remain vigilant when making arrests in such situations and if possible, to keep the police communications centers notified of their locations during such actions.

NEW YORK — An off-duty police officer was arrested Monday for allegedly shooting a man who was cleaning car windows with a squeegee.


Officer Michael Meyer, 28, was charged with attempted murder, assault, reckless endangerment, and weapons possession.

Meyer allegedly shot Antoinne Reid, 37, in the chest Sunday afternoon as Reid was cleaning car windows near an expressway in the Bronx, Sgt. Cory Cuneo said.

Reid was in critical condition early Monday.

Meyer was suspended without pay from his job in the police building maintenance department.

New York Mayor Giuliani Gives Commencement Speech at Cooper Union Art School While Artists Are Being Arrested Outside

Mayor Giuliani today gave the commencement address to the graduating class of the Cooper Union

Art, Architecture and Engineering School, ignoring a petition signed by a majority of the graduating class that asked him not to attend. The school, located at 3rd Avenue and St Marks Place in the East Village, was ringed by a special N.Y.P.D. Task Force in anticipation of a demonstration by members of A.R.T.I.S.T.

Police attempted to force a small group of artist/protesters displaying satirical portraits of Mayor Giuliani to set up inside a police barricade located oneand-a-half blocks from the school, a location that was almost completely out of sight or sound of the building. The artists, led by Robert Lederman, then attempted to locate the protest on the traffic island at St Marks Place between 3rd and 4th Avenues where a giant sculpture of a cube is located.



Veganism # Tdeology

The quotes which you've picked up on refer more to lifestylism than veganism in particular. We've 'shrugged off' lifestylism because that's more of a social club than a revolutionary movement - and I suppose you're right, as part of the dismissal of the 'everybody MUST live like us' crew, we've 'shrugged off' aspects of veganism as well. I say 'aspects' because I don't think we've ever slagged the actual diet off.

Most of us were vegans in the eighties. We saw animal rights move from being one issue among many to THE most important battle for many people. Because animals are 'victims' (who don't answer back) it was always easy for people to get involved in animal rights. You can think capitalism is a fine system, that the working classes should work harder, that women should be demure and feminine, without it ever contradicting your stand on animal rights.

The so-called "Vegan Reich" dickheads (who rose like scum in the late eighties) were proof that veganism didn't necessarily mean libertarian politics. They were a bunch of young, white males who said that every animal had a right to life and to them that meant abortion was morally wrong. They were against a woman's right to choose.

So what I'm trying to say really is that I'm not suspicious of the vegan diet BUT I am wary of people who use 'vegan' as a political label. There's a few reasons for this, not least because there's usually a hint of people enjoying the fact that they're denying themselves something. Fasting has long been popular with religious zealots because the sense of doing without for a cause is a high in itself.

People who have to live and work in the real world do without, not because of choice, but because capitalism rests on the majority having less than they need. The rich wouldn't be rich if we weren't poor. Wanting to save animals is a fine philosophy, who could quarrel with it? What I would question is the assumption that if we all

It seems that food politics, however important (and it is important) is one more single-issue sideline. The main criticism is that these single issues all too often get in the way of the greater battle - and that battle has to begin in defence of people, not animals.

Since we made 'Pictures of Starving Children' we've seen the rise of alternative capitalism. Stopping buying one product means picking up another. That doesn't mean we don't fucking care, it just means that we've realised that there's a bigger job to be done. Destroying capitalism

eclipses veganism in terms of political priorities. Maybe we've gone overboard on pushing that line but the problem is that some vegans, like some animal rights types, can't see further than the proverbial horse's arse. What's wrong with **McDonald's?**

In Court - The Legal Battle

I cannot think of a case in which the legal cards have been so spectacularly stacked against one party.' [Legal commentator, Marcel Berlins]

We decided to fight, representing ourselves (Legal Aid denied for libel cases) through 28 pre-trial hearings. Our right to a jury trial was also denied. McDonald's was represented pre-trial by a top QC. He confidently officially predicted a '3-4 week trial'. In fact it lasted 314 court days in which we ourselves were grilling corporate executives and officials, dozens of experts and witness of fact, fielding our own witnesses (none of whom were paid) and also having constant legal disputes (including 7 trips to the Court of Appeal). The case had turned into a public tribunal in which 'McWorld' was on trial. McDonald's spent an estimated 10 million pounds as against our total of \$35,000 raised from public donations.

I believe that the critics of the company and the food industry in general were completely vindicated by the evidence, the judge making some damning major findings against the company's core business practices - that they

'exploit children' with their advertising, pay 'low wages', make 'deceptive' nutritional claims and are 'culpably responsible' for cruelty to animals. In my view only controversial legal and semantic interpretations by the judge prevented us winning on all points. McDonald's then capitulated by abandoning all efforts to get costs, damages or an injunction. As experienced campaigners we felt throughout that what really counted was the court of public opinion, and the determination of activists to refuse to be silenced and to ensure that an oppressive law could be made unworkable by co-ordinated mass defiance. This is what happened in this case.

We have lodged a comprehensive Appeal to be heard staring on January 12, against the unfair and oppressive fundamentals of UK libel laws, including invoking European law. This could be an unparalleled opportunity to stimulate debate, and to challenge the unacceptable mass use of libel as censorship.

## Outside Court - The Campaign

'Observers believe it will go down as the biggest Corporate PR disaster in history.' [Channel 4 News]

McDonald's brought the case to suppress the dissemination (at that time in the thousands) of London Greenpeace anti-McDonald's leaflets. However, 3 million have been handed out on the streets in the UK alone since the writs were served (400,000 given out the weekend after the verdict), and there have been over a million more handed out in solidarity protests all over the world, leaflets now available in at least 26 languages. The McLibel Support Campaign was set up to galvanise the great public interest and support, to help with legal finances and practical tasks ... but most importantly to back the grass-roots leafletters, thousands of whom signed a Pledge to continue to disseminate leaflets before, during and after the trial in defiance of the law.

Despite the campaign being run on half a shoe-string from an office in someone's bedroom, it succeeded in ensuring that the private and often obscure legal battle in the courtroom became a public issue fought and won in the court of public opinion and on the street.

The Body Shop have successfully poverty around the world. Also, the mass manufactured an image of being a caring company that is helping to protect the environment and indigenous peoples, and preventing the suffering of animals - whilst selling 'natural' products. But behind the green and cuddly image lies the reality - the Body Shop's operations, like those of all multinationals, have a detrimental effect on the environment and the world's poor. They do not help the plight of animals or indigenous peoples (and may be having a harmful effect), and their products are far from what they're cracked up to be. They have put themselves on a pedestal in order to exploit people's idealism - so this leaflet has been written as a necessary response.

Companies like the Body Shop continually hype their products, often creating a demand for something where a real need for it does not exist. The message pushed is that the route to happiness is through buying more and more of their products. The increasing domination of multinationals and their standardised products is leading to global cultural conformity. The world's problems will only be tackled by curbing such consumerism - one of the fundamental causes of world poverty, environmental destruction and social alienation.

FUELLING CONSUMPTION AT THE EARTH'S EXPENSE The Body Shop have over 1,500 stores in 47 countries, and aggressive expansion plans. Their main purpose (like all multinationals) is making lots of money for their rich shareholders. In other words, they are driven by power and greed. But the Body Shop try to conceal this reality by continually pushing the message that by shopping at their stores, rather than elsewhere, people will help solve some of the world's problems. The truth is that nobody can make the world a better place by shopping.

20% of the world's population consume 80% of its resources. A high standard of living for some people means gross social inequalities and those tested since then (if they were animaltested for some purpose other than for cosmetics). There continue to be concerns about the enforcement of their policy. Also, some Body Shop items contain animal products such as gelatine (crushed bone).

Caring for our bodies? - The cosmetics industry, which includes the Body Shop, tries to make women - and increasingly now also men feel inadequate and insecure about their bodies, and pushes the message that people need 'beautifying'. Women especially are often put under pressure to conform to the impossible physical ideals set by money-oriented industries and the media. Let's appreciate everyone's natural beauty and dignity.

LOW PAY AND AGAINST UNIONS The Body Shop pay their store workers low wages at or near the expected minimum wage and well below the official European 'decency threshold' for pay. The company is opposed to trade unions, ensuring that they keep labour costs down and that employees are not able to improve their working conditions. None of their workers are unionised so employees are forced to channel their grievances and demands through procedures completely controlled by the company. This isolates workers and denies them ve bargaining power.

production, packaging and transportation of huge quantities of goods is using up the world's resources faster than they can be renewed and filling the land, sea and air with dangerous pollution and waste. Those who advocate an ever-increasing level of consumption, and equate such consumption with personal well-being, economic progress and social fulfilment, are creating a recipe for ecological disaster.

Rejecting consumerism does not mean also rejecting our basic needs, our stylishness, our real choices or our quality of life. It is about creating a just, stable and sustainable world, where resources are under the control of local communities and are distributed equally and spanngly - it's about improving everyone's quality of life. Consuming ever more things is an unsatisfying and harmful way to try to be happy and fulfilled. Human happiness is not related to what people buy, but to who we are and how we relate to each other. LET'S CONSUME LESS AND LIVE MORE!

## MISLEADING THE PUBLIC

Natural products? - The Body Shop give the impression that their products are made from mostly natural ingredients. In fact like all big cosmetic companies they make wide use of nonrenewable petrochemicals, synthetic colours, fragrances and preservatives, and in many of their products they use only tiny amounts of botanicalbased ingredients. Some experts have warned about the potential adverse effects on the skin of some of the synthetic ingredients. The Body Shop also regularly irradiate certain products to try to kill microbes - radiation is generated from dangerous non-renewable uranium which cannot be disposed of safely.

Helping animals? - Although the Body Shop maintain that they are against animal testing, they do not always make clear that many of the ingredients in their products have been tested on animals by other companies, causing much pain and suffering to those animals. They accept ingredients tested on animals before 1991, or to safeguard the Indians' future interests. Furthermore, the company have used them extensively for PR purposes for which they have not been compensated.

Such projects take attention away from the need to oppose the threats to the survival of indigenous peoples. Rather than encouraging them to be tied into the market economy controlled by foreign companies, people should be supporting their freedom to control their own land and resources and therefore their future.

One recent Body Shop advertisement extolled their commitment to indigenous peoples and the American Express card (the ultimate symbol of consumerism). At the time American Express/ was a major backer of a massive hydroelectric scheme due to flood vast areas of Cree Indian land in Quebec against Cree opposition.

As the Body Shop rely so CENSORSHIP heavily on their 'green', 'caring' image, they have threatened or brought legal action against some of those who have criticised them, trying to stifle legitimate public discussion. It's vital to stand up to intimidation and to defend free speech.

WHAT YOU CAN DO Together we can fight back against the institutions and the people in power who dominate our lives and our planet. and do organise tog her to their rights and dignity. People are increasingly aware of the need to think seriously about the products we use, and to consume less. People in poor countries are organising themselves to stand up to multinationals and banks which dominate the world's economy. Environmental and animal rights protests and campaigns are growing everywhere. Why not join in the struggle for a better world? 

EXPLOITING INDIGENOUS PEOPLES The Body Shop claim to be helping some third world workers and indigenous peoples through socalled 'Trade Not Aid' or 'Community Trade' projects. In fact, these are largely a marketing ploy as less than 1% of sales go to 'Community Trade' producers, and it has been shown that some of these products have been sourced from mainstream commercial markets. One such project, which has been the centrepiece of the company's marketing strategy for years, is with the Kayapo Indians in Brazil. The Body Shop have claimed that by harvesting brazil nut oil (used in hair conditioner), the Indians are able to make sustainable use of the forest thereby preventing its destruction by mining and logging companies. But only a small number of the Kayapo are involved, creating resentment and internal divisions within the community. As the Body Shop are the sole buyer of the oil, they can set any price they like. ## Birth of a Computer Catastrophe

From the C-Span symposium by The Center for Strategic and International Studies, which is devoted to the problems that are going to be generated by the millenium bug.

The consensus of the group was that the year 2000, and even before that, the government, and the corporations are going to self-distruct. They predict an anarchic world without communications, and a total shut-down of all the services we take for granted. They predict famine, chaos, and anarchy. These corporate advisors take note of the fact that the vast majority of corporations, and the government itself, will not be able to change over their computer systems in time, and that every satelite in the sky will go dead.

They also predict that this will take place at a time when a new depression will hit that will ruin everyone. They advised their clients to forget every other issue. The Euro for example is a lost cause. They called for a massive mobilization of resources to attack, not the problem of changing the computers, but to institute contingency measures with the certainty that the time has long passed for a technical solution.

Yet another high concept movie script from the overheated coke fiends of Hollywood?

No, none of the above.

The computer virus that causes heart arrhythmia comes straight from the US Army War College's academic journal, Parameters. Writing in the spring 1998 issue, just hot off the presses, Lieutenant Colonel Timothy L. Thomas, an analyst at the Foreign Military Studies Office at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, delivers this unexpurgated phlogiston: "... one computer virus capable of affecting a person's psyche is Russian Virus 666. It manifests itself in every 25th frame of a visual display, where it produces a combination of colors that allegedly put computer users into a trance. The subconscious perception of the new pattern eventually results in arrhythmia of the heart."

Silicon valley once boasted orange groves and a lovely suburban lifestyle that not so long ago attracted people to California in the first place. Now it's a toxic dump. The process involved in manufacturing computers is toxic. The landfills created by never-ending march of obsolete, discarded computers are The products manufactured by computerized robots and toxic. machinery are toxic. The perfectly fine, long lasting machinery discarded and replaced by computers is often toxic. The radiation coming out of the color screens into your face is toxic. The cyberworld mindset is toxic, I would say by its very definition. The majority of computer use by the military, FBI, CIA, local law enforcement, and industrial manufacturers is toxic. The unbelievable (which began in the early 1960's) created by these unemployment labor saving devices is toxic. In short, computers suck.

**Electricity** A 150-watt current of electricity, enough to power two incandescent light bulbs, had brought the computer to life. The United States owns 40 percent of the world's 300 million computers. Computers take 5 percent of the electricity used in American offices. In comparison, lighting uses 20–25 percent.

A gun inside my monitor sent a beam of electrons across the 20-inch display, lighting colored phosphors on the inside of the screen and a precise pattern of pixels on the outside: I had no E-mail. The display consumed about as much power as the rest of the computer's components combined. A "screen saver" popped up on my screen after a few minutes, but the images of swimming tropical fish saved no electricity: my monitor used as much power as ever. Most of the time that personal computers are turned on, they are not actually being used. In addition, onethird of computers in the United States are left on at night and on weekends.

A Texas factory made my circuit boards. Their manufacture used more chemicals, energy, and water, and generated more hazardous waste, than the making of any other part of my computer. Machines cut boards made of copper, fiberglass, and epoxy resin to size, drilled holes in them, and cleaned them. In a process not unlike making chips, the holes were plated with a thin layer of copper and the boards etched with circuit patterns. This process generated airborne par-

Monitor When I use my computer, I don't see the chips, chip packages, and circuit boards hard at work on the inside. All I pay attention to is what appears on the screen

The sides of the CRT were soldered to the front panel with lead oxide and heated, fusing the parts together to form a bulb. Discarded color monitors are classified as hazardous waste bed in the glass. By the year 2005, about 150 million personal computers will have been sent to landfills in the United States. They will occupy about 300 million cubic fect, equivalent to a football field stacked a mile high in computer trash. Ships, planes, and trucks brought the various computer components to California plants, where they were assembled. The finished computer was carefully boxed with polystyrene foam inserts and trucked to a suburban superstore. I ordered it over the phone; a delivery truck brought it to my office. In all, the factories making my 55pound computer generated 139 pounds of waste and used 7,300 gallons of water and 2,300 kilowatt-hours of energy (about one-fourth the energy the computer would use over its four-year lifetime).

**Chips** The beige computer that stares at me 40 hours a week consists of about 55 pounds of plastics, metals, glass, and silicon. ticulates, acid tumes, VOCs [volatile organic compounds], and other chemical wastes.

Then the boards were plated with layers of copper and of tin-lead solder. The tin was imported from Brazil, and the lead was recovered from dead car batteries in Houston. Recycled lead meets 60 percent of U.S. demand annually. The United States consumes half the world's lead, mostly for car parts. Because the lead is highly toxic and hard to dispose of legally, 90 percent of car batteries are recycled after use. Yet lead waste from electronic goods is almost never recycled. Scattered throughout the computer, lead solder is costly to recycle.

Etching and cleaning left behind a pattern of copper wiring on the circuit boards. Assembling and soldering the boards also produced lead, copper, VOCs, and solvent wastes.







they were going to force this defense on me in spite of my bitter resistance to it.

For the present I will not review in detail what happened between late November, 1997 and January 22, 1998. Suffice it to say that the judge in my case, Garland E, Burrell, decided that my attorneys had the legal right to force their defense on me over my objections; that it was too late for me to replace my attorneys with a certain distinguished attorney who had offered to represent me and had stated his intention to use a defense not based on any supposed mental illness; and that it was too late for me to demand the right to act as my own attorney.


This put me in such a position that I had only one way left to prevent my attorneys from using false information to represent me to the world as insane: I agreed to plead guilty to the charges in exchange for withdrawal of the prosecution's


virtually portray me as insane, and that leaves me with a virtual certainty of spending my life in prison. I am not afraid of the death penalty, and I agreed to this bargain only to end the trial and thus prevent my attorneys from representing me as insane. It should be noted that the defense my attorneys had planned could not have led to my release; it was only intended to save me from the death penalty.

> By concealing their intentions from me and discouraging me from finding another attorney before it was too late, my attorneys have done me very great harm: They have forced me to sacrifice my right to an appeal that might have led to my release; they have already made public the opinions of supposed experts who portray me as crazy; and they have caused me to lose my opportunity to be represented by a distinguished attorney who would have portrayed me in a very different light.


had prepared a defense that would to give up all right to appeal, which Perhaps I ought to hate my attorneys for what they have done to me, but I do not. Their motives were in no way malicious. They are essentially conventional people who are blind to some of the implications of this case, and they acted as they did because they subscribe to certain professional principles that they believe left them no alternative. These principles may seem rigid and even ruthless to a non-lawyer, but there is no doubt that my attornerys believe in them sincerely. Moreover, on a personal level my attorneys have treated me with great generosity and have performed many kindnesses for me. (But these can never compensate for the harm they have done me through their handling of my case.)

> Recent events constitute a major defeat for me. But the end is not yet. More will be heard from me in the future.

The Institute of Arable Crops Research (IACR), had planned to demonstrate the wheat, designed to have improved bread-making quality, to farmers at the "Cereals 98," exhibition taking place in Sleaford, eastern England.

But the wheat had become a focus for the ire of environmental groups opposed to genetic engineering and before it could be shown to thepublic, all the wheat on the demonstration plot was destroyed. "All the plants were pulled up on Monday afternoon," a spokesman for IACR said. The damage was done by a group of protesters called the "Lincolnshire Lotters," a spokeswoman for the campaigning group Genetic Engineering Network said.

"I deeply deplore the damage done to a demonstration plot of genetically modified spring wheat at the Cereals '98 site, particularly as the material was out specifically set to stimulate open, constructive debate about plant genetic manipulation," IACR's director, Professor Ben Miflin said in a statement respondthe damage. ing to

"If ever there was a clear case of agrochemical companies placing their profits before the safety of our food and our environment, genetic engineering is it. Nobody has asked for these Frankenstein foods, most people actively dislike them and yet we are not even being consulted on what goes in our mouths. Four government conservation agencies have called for these fields to be halted yet Jeff Rooker [UK food minister] recently stated that he was not in the driving seat on this issue. Well, if the government can't act to protect our interests then we've got to. This morning, due to responsible and peaceful direct actions, we are seven fields closer to a safer world."

## MONSANTO'S GE BULLSHIT RETURNED

Staff turning up for work at Monsanto's offices in both London and High Wycombe recently were greeted by a pile of bullshit which bore the message: "WE DON'T WANT MONSANTO'S BULLSHIT". A banner above the door read "KEEP ORGANIC FREE OF GENETIC ENGINEERING" (see photo below).

Super Heroes Against Genetics swooped in to alert the world to Monsanto's plans to contaminate organic food with genetically modified organisms. The action came as the US Department of Agriculture (USDA) concluded a 6-month consultation period on the definition of organic standards. This received over 100,000 complaints from around the world, particularly focussing on proposals to classify genetically engineered food as organic.



FOOD PROTESTERS RAID RESEARCH FARM

SAFE food campaigners have carried out a raid to destroy genetically engineered plants at a research farm. Scientists claim the attack has put back research by at least five years.

Target for the raid was a farm at Inkberrow, near Redditch, Worcs. Crops are tested there in a bid to find varieties that will give a bigger yield without the need for pesticides. The protesters cut down half an acre of a specially grown oil seed rape crop then boasted about their success onthe Internet.





ENVIRONMENTAL protestors calling themselves the "Lincolnshire Loppers" have destroyed a plot of the UK's first field-grown genetically-modified spring wheat.

Last night, in an escalation of popular action against 'frankenstein food', seven separate least at crops of genetically engineered rapeseed were destroyed across the UK. The Genetic Engineering Network was informed of these peaceful direct actions this morning by a reliable anonymous source.

They appear to have been strategically chosen and brings the total number of known genetic field 'decontaminations' in the UK to 19. It may be that these nightime activities could prevent this particular controversial crop coming to market.

The crops which together cover approximately 10,000 sq metres were cut down using common gardening tools and bare hands. It is likely that hundreds of thousands of pounds worth of damage will have been sustained. This is a significant blow to companies already feeling the effects of public distrust and crop failures.

Genetic Engineering Network PO BOX 9656 London N4 4JY On March 3, 1998, the U. S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the Delta and Pine Land Company, a Mississippi firm and the largest cotton seed company in the world, announced that they had jointly developed and received a patent (US patent number 5,723,765) on a new, agricultural biotechnology. Benignly titled, "Control of Plant Gene Expression", the new patent will permit its owners and licensees to create sterile seed by cleverly and selectively programming a plant's DNA to kill its own embryos.

The patent applies to plants and seeds of all species. The result? If saved at harvest for future crops, the seed produced by these plants will not grow. Pea pods, tomatoes, peppers, heads of wheat and ears of corn will essentially become seed morgues. In one broad, brazen stroke of his hand, humans will have irretrievably broken the plant - to seed - to - plant - to - seed - cycle, THE cycle that supports most life on the planet. No seed, no food unless you buy more seed. This is obviously good for seed companies. As it turns out, it is also good for the US Department of Agriculture.

# RECLAIN THE STREETS!

## Berkeley Roundup By J.

About 700 people in Berkeley "reclaimed the streets" on May 16, as part of an international Global Street Party against the global economy and the global environmental destruction it is causing.

Berkeley RTS gathered at the downtown BART station at 7 p.m. The large crowd, half on foot and half on bikes, marched down the street a few blocks waiving black flags and carrying a 25 foot long banner reading "Take back our lives--Reclaim the Streets." Then the march divided with the bikes peddling straight for a Critical Mass to the secret location of the Street Party while the march turned left. On the way to the Street Party location, the march picked up couches, rugs and other props that had been left the night before in hidden locations. At Telegraph Avenue, the march and the Critical Mass ride triumphantly met up with couches, bikes and flags held high. The rejoined group took a side trip to get around a line of cops and finally ended up at the intersection selected for the Street Party. An advance "action group" had already blockaded Telegraph Ave. with an old donated car and blocked a side street with dumpsters and signs. The intersection had been reclaimed!

A mobile sound system churned out tunes while the intersection was transformed into a living room with dozens of couches, rugs and miscellaneous furniture. Free food tables were set up, folks smashed up and overturned the car, smoked pot, danced and socialized. A TV smashing got a little out of hand as glass covered the dance floor. Then parts of the crowd ignited a toxic bonfire with some of from an RTS flyer distributed in the UK:

the couches, while other people in the crowd repeatedly put out the fire. Finally, the fire was extinguished and the party got into full swing, lasting several hours. Activists handed out about 1,000 flyers explaining the politics behind the event: "Welcome to a rupture of the everyday. Before you is a street party: a community festival on the [paved over] town square. By dancing and playing--turning the pavement into a playground--we are reclaiming the street from the automobile which ruins the street by making it a place to be moved through not lived in. We believe the city and the street should be for people to live, meet others and celebrate creativity and freedom. The city should serve the human community, not mechanized consumerism. Cars are only the most visible and tangible representative of an inhuman consumer society which is smashing community, constricting human spontaneity and freedom and destroying the Earth's life




power of the Global Street Party and the more sedate but more numerous Jubilee 2000 human chain. The news that Tony Blair was to lead his band of international ne'er-do-wells and their vast battalions (ie. hairdressers, jokewriters, media sycophants, spin doctors etc) of cronies to a sumptuous, secluded rural retreat to better ponder the perils of international crime ... made absolutely no difference to the 60,000 or so who had a point to make that Saturday afternoon. When the polite but impassioned plea of the 50,000 debt relief human chainers had subsided, an altogether wilder and less conciliatory note began to be heard from the region of New Street Station, as pulses sped and sweating clowns were spotted making ready to laugh in the face of the G8 in the adrenalised melee.

Then suddenly at 4.30 the crowd (by now about 8,000) felt a tug towards the waiting road, and the reclamatory hordes poured onto the Bull Ring roundabout, the waiting police looking on powerlessly. A huge circle of tarmac surrounding a sunken market place was brought to a standstill as the partygoers revelled in their new freedom of the open road. For at least half an hour it was uncertain what would be our territory for the rest of the night. One tripod went up and came back down along with its occupant; another stayed up only to find itself stranded behind a police line; another staked our territory successfully, marking an endpoint beyond which all that could be seen were the hundreds of police vans from all over the country containing riot gear patiently waiting to be donned. Eventually we laid claim to half the circle and got down to the party. A bangin' techno sound system encased this time inside a private car provided the bulk of the entertainment while at the fringes fire was eaten and odd passages of unamplified music were heard occasionally. A second system and various other props couldn't make it through the police lines. Nifty lamppost scalers had soon decorated and contextualised the. space with banners reading 'Protest is Hope' (underneath the G8 Joker), 'Beneath the Tarmac the Grass', a huge red kitelike masterpiece with floating yellow tassles bearing the names of all the global street parties, and of course not forgetting that old favourite: 'Reclaim the Streets'. Other banners, like 'Local Vibes Not Global Lies' for instance, didn't make it up.

Boxes of lettuce, tomatoes and cucumber, some brought up to the road by market traders, became slapstick weapons, sailing through the air into police lines (on the odd occasion they were accurately aimed.) When twenty policemen moved in apparently to remove the sound system they found more resistance than their superior officer had obviously expected, and beat a hasty retreat. One slightly less hasty P.C found himself the recipient of an unexpected gift from a nimble clown: a perfectly baked and perfectly aimed custard pie. It's doubtful whether he'll be regaling his grandchildren with the tale of his long, dignified walk back to the safety of the police line, half his face immaculately smeared in creamy custard.

As dusk began to fall the party continued full pelt (as it were), some determined to have a good time in their temporary autonomous zone, others equally determined to have 'discussions' with by-now riot geared-up law enforcement types. A white car abandoned hours before became the object of some fairly intense scrutiny, so intense in fact that it ended up on its back, but not incinerated. (The crowd was split between those who wanted to build a funeral pyre to car culture, and those who were worried either about safety or the impression it would send out.)

The Stars + Stripes and the Union Jack made a pretty pair as they were ceremonially torched atop a bus-stop. Then it came time to depart for pastures new (ie. a local club), our seasoned diplomats negotiated with the police, the result being the safe passage out of the sound system. Thus the blessed system was slowly escorted off site and across town by over a 1000 people, all the way to the pre-arranged after-party party venue. That this procession departed unscathed by riot police was a real example of the power of determined citizens over a pushy police presence.



Anyway, the stomach-turning sight of the G8 leaders joining together for a chorus of 'All You Need Is Love' close by that evening was more than made up for by the heart-warming vision of Birmingham - not to mention 38 other towns and cities in 23 other countries - reclaimed.

NEW YORK (UPS)-International Telephone and Telegraph got a taste of its own medicine the other day when a number of Zippie sisters and the Emma Goldman Brigade staged guerrilla theater in the lobby of the corporation's New York headquarters

The demonstration was to protest the use of tiny sensors made by IT ped along trails in the Southeast Asia war zone. Five days later, on April 12, almost 500 people gathered outside the ITT building for a nstration called by Women's Strike for Peace. For 45 minutes 150 people and a dog lay down on the curb outside the building to pro-test the corporation's role in the Indochina war. By altering these billboards, HOCUS FOCUS is taking action against corporate cooptation and its strategy of MARKETING AS CENSORSHIP.

As proof that Apple marketers aren't committed to the challenge of these thinkers' imaginations, HOCUS FOCUS points to Apple's censorship of their own ad campaign by dropping the Dalai Lama from billboards in Asia.

WE ARE NOT ALONE: a Dalai Lama billboard in San Carlos has been recontextualized to read "Think: disillusioned" by unknown artists.



# Free Radio Berkeley hit with injunction

In the wake of Federal Judge Claudia Wilken's issuance of an injunction ordering Free Radio Berkeley (FRB) off the air on June 16, former Free Radio DJs have gone underground to carry on on their fight for free speech.

The injunction is extremely broad, prohibiting Free Radio founder Stephen Dunifer "and all persons in active concert or participation with him" from "making radio transmissions" or "doing any act, whether direct or indirect, to cause unlicensed radio transmissions or to enable such radio transmissions to occur." Following issuance of the injunction, the FRB collective voted to temporarily shut down the transmitter. Later the station's landlord cut power to the transmitter permanently.

"We're going back on the air no matter what the law and the injunction says," said an anonymous, masked radio broadcaster speaking from a new, secret broadcast location. On June 20, at 8 p.m., a radio signal on 104.1, Free Radio Berkeley's old frequency, could clearly be heard in the Berkeley area. An unknown voice announced that a new, micro-radio revolutionary-cell would make regular Sunday night broadcasts at 104.1 starting at 8 p.m., with more times and days possible as the situation develops. Because of the draconian language of the court injunction, the new station is currently being operated separately from Free Radio Berkeley.

From an FRB press release: "The FCC, ignoring its mission to regulate radio broadcasting "in the public interest," has developed rules that effectively concentrate radio ownership in the hands of large corporations while leaving the public excluded. The national free radio movement is challenging these FCC rules. Micro power radio, because it is cheap and easy for community groups to operate, offers a unique opportunity for voices unheard on mainstream media to be heard.

The injunction, which represents the latest FCC attempt to dodge the core issue of free speech--is based on a legal technicality. In fact, Federal Judge Claudia Wilken in her June 16 order explicitly states that "this ruling is not based on the merits of [Free Radio Berkeley's] criticisms of the FCC's refusal to license micro broadcasters." "The government has failed to show" Judge Wilken previously wrote, "[]whether the FCC's complete prohibition of micro radio is constitutional..."

Free Radio Berkeley was operating 24 hours a day with 100 volunteer disc jockies on an unused frequency. The station's unlicensed broadcasts were an act of civil disobedience to try to change FCC rules so that Free Radio Berkeley and hundreds of other community micro-powered stations across America could be legally licensed to broadcast."



## How To Sink Whalers, Driftnetters, and Other Environmentally Destructive Ships

Before we begin. I have a few rules that I must first interject. Rule number one, no guns or explosives. I will *never* advocate them. We want to protect all life. You can sink whalers, driftnetters, and toxic-dumping ships by scuttling them. Using explosives can obviously risk life and will definitely be very counterproductive with the media. If you get caught with them, you can expect to do long *time*. If you are still interested in explosives, then stop right here and go get a U.S. Navy Seals manual and a U.S. Army Improvised Munitions book. But read no further. And rule number two, no actions against the navies that might be guarding these ships. We only want to get the culprits.

When a ship goes underwater, salt water does terrible damage to all mechanical, electrical, refrigeration, and naviontic systems. Sea water is amongst the most corrosive liquids known. Even if they refloat the ship (and often they must if only because the sunken ship is now blocking the harbor), the ship will be out of commission for many months. The financial damage done to the ship is often over one-half the value of ship. We have cases where we have scuttled ships (the two Icelandic whalers for example) where the ships were refloated only to be scrapped. Those ships never killed another whale.

**One other thing that I must mention:** Scuttling ships is *not* a college prank. It can be *deadly serious*. Get caught in Norway and you'll do time. Get caught in Kaohsiung harbor in Taiwan and, after a forced interogation, they might deposit your body at the bottom of the harbor. This is not kids' stuff. Never forget that 'SINK' is a four-letter word. You have been warned.

But with the scuttling of ecologically destructive ships comes the possibility of doing literally tens of millions of dollars of direct and economic damage. We are talking *mega-tage* here. The joy of bringing down a whaler. of sticking a harpoon up their collective asses, can be one of the great pleasures in an ecowarrior's life. It can be the most-treasured of feathers in one's spiritual war bonnet.

## **Tool List**

It is our experience that you can quickly and easily get almost all the tools you will need in the country where you will be doing the scuttling. In fact, you must. We would not recommend going through customs with a one-meter long set of bolt cutters. We ourselves have never had difficulty in getting all the tools we need in the country where we are to do the scuttling. Often there are pawn shops around seaport towns and you can buy what you need there. We would advise buying your tools in some town other than where the ship is. It may not be a good idea to stay in the town where the ship is docked. Yes, the best traveler leaves no footprints, and the best ecoteur leaves no monkey-prints.

There are two items on our list that you will have difficulty getting locally. Those are the lock-picking set and the CS tear gas. Both are important. You could disassemble and smuggle a small lock-picking kit into the country where you are going, but if you get caught with it, that will be the end of your action.

Do not fly with tear gas. If you can safely obtain it or something else equally nauseating in the country where the action is to take place, then definitely do it.

- large pipe wrench
- large crescent wrench
- large pry (crow) bar
  phillips and flat-blade screwdrivers
- vice grips
- flashlights and headlamps
- lock-picking kit (and knowledge of how to use it! there are books that explain how to do this)
- gloves, waterproof clothing, tarpolin
  a dark set of disposable clothes (black is always the most fashionable color for scuttlers)
- flexible rubber gloves
- a complete change of clothes.
- two long, heavy-duty high quality pad locks per ship
- a half-full bottle of hard liquor
- · soap and water to clean up with




The critical factor in sinking a ship is being able to sneak aboard it *undetected*. If you can do that, you can bring the ship down. *The actual mechanics of sinking* the ship is not nearly as difficult as locating the ship and boarding it undetected.

All ships come to dock for repairs and preparation for the next season. It is at this point that it is possible to sneak aboard the ship for scuttling. There will be times when no one is on board the ship. We do not think that you can scuttle a ship when someone else is aboard it. They will detect you. Nor would it be desirable to try. Typically, nights and holidays are the best times to board any ship undetected. The ships may be moored next to the dock, or anchored out at harbor. You may need a collapsible kayak to get to it. Or you may have to 'borrow' a rowboat. You must be able to determine when no one is aboard. This can require much observation. But in some cases when we have found the boat, we have

#### STEP 1 BOARD THE SHIP UNDETECTED


I advise that you first board the ship and then hide yourself and your tools. Wear rubber gloves at all times and *do not take them off.* You can hide in the stairwells, in the middle of gear stacked on the deck, or wherever. You could carry a tarpolin and hide under it. Then wait: For ten or fifteen minutes, *do not move.* If someone has seen you board the ship, this will give them time to come searching for you, and you will find out if you have been seen or not. If they are going to catch you, it is much better that they catch you while you are just trespassing, rather than sabotaging. The penalties are not nearly as severe. You should have a half-full bottle of hard liquor with you. Take a swig or two so that you have booze on your breath. If they catch you, you should try to pas's yourself off as just another drunk sailor in port. In many port towns, this is not very unusual. Also, if you think you are going to be caught at this point, try to dump your toolbag into the water. If they find both you and the bag, your toolbag will be very incriminating.

#### STEP 2 GET INTO THE ENGINE ROOM.

You may have to cut or pick locks, use r y bars, or even cutting torches to get in. But quite possibly, the doors will b wide open. Typically, the entrance to the engine room is near the stern of the ship. Once you get into the ship, keep going down. The engine room is at the bottom of the ship. Eventually, you will find it. Its door may be locked. If so, you will now be able to open its lock in privacy. The engine room is an oily, toxic-waste filled area. Typically, you will get dirty with the rust and oil in this room.

### STEP 3 FIND THE SEA WATER INTAKE VALVE.

All large ocean-going ships have salt water intake valves and piping. These ships need salt water for deck-cleaning, fire-fighting, and for cooling their massive diesel engines. There are no air-cooled diesel engines out at sea. Usually, the coolant radiator from the diesel engine is bathed in a steady stream of cool sea water. The best way to find the sea water intake valve is to *follow the piping*. Ocean-going ships typically will have four or five different types of plumbing. Fresh water, salt water, fuel oil, engine oil, and hydraulic fluid. The salt water in the engine room. The trick is to keep following the pipes to the thickest one that appears to be attached to the side or the bottom of the ship. It is at this point that the sea water enters the ship.


STEP 4 REMOVE THE HANDLE FROM THE VALVE.

The valve handle may look either like a steering wheel or a lever type handle. Take it off. You will probably have to remove a retaining bolt that is holding the handle on. Do it and then pull the handle off. Hide the handle somewhere away from the valve stem. When you are done, we should just have a valve stem protruding outward from the valve.

determined immediately that no one was aboard (for example, no tracks in the snow on or around the ship). We have then gone in and sunk that ship on the spot.

Each situation is different. With increased observation, you run the risk of being observed yourself and blowing your cover. If they become suspicious of you, you will *not* be able to sink the ship. Surprise is everything. At a certain point, you must decide whether the action is 'do-able' or not. If you think it is, then at a certain point you must decide when it is time to go in for the kill and do it.

Be sure to get the right ship. Make sure that it is an active whaler or driftnetter or whatever. Only sink the ships that are guilty of environmental devastation.



## is at the bottom of the ship, but it can be on the side.

There is one exception that I should mention now, that of ships with keel-cooling systems. Keel-cooling ships are ships that pump their engine coolant directly into cooling pipes attached to the keel (outside) of the ship. They do not use internal heat exchange with salt water. Keel-cooling ships typically just stay in colder waters. Norwegian whalers use keel-cooling systems. But ships with keelcooling systems still have salt-water intake systems. They still need sca water for deck-cleaning and firefighting. Their sea water intakes are not as large as those on non-keel-cooling ships, but they are still plenty adequate for scuttling. When we sank the Norwegian pirate whaling ship the *Nybrena* on December 27th, 1992, it had a keel-cooling system.

#### STEP 3 CLOSE THE SEA WATER INTAKE VALVE.

This is the master valve that controls the entrance of all the sea water coming into the ship. You need to close this so that you can you can cut off the pressure to the piping. If the ship is in dock for any amount of time, they should have closed the valve already. But we have boarded ships and found the valve left open. We have had to shut the valve, do our work, and then reopen the valve to sink the



We take the handle off so that if they find the ship in the process of sinking, they cannot easily shut off the valve.

STEP 5 NOW DISCONNECT THE PIPING COMING OUT OF THE VALVE. Now that you have closed the valve, you have removed the water pressure from the system and you can work more easily. You must now use your pipe wrench, crescent wrench, and perhaps vice grips to remove the pipe or plating that is near to the intake valve. The larger the pipe you remove, the better. You will have to improvise here. Study the pipes and find one that you can take off. As you are taking the bolts off, do not be surprised

(CONT. FROM PC. 29) if water starts spraying out. This is water that is already in the system and you are now bleeding it out. It will stop draining shortly.

Please note: *Remove the pipe*. Do not just loosen it. Take your time and take all the bolts off and *remove it*. Carry the pipe away from where you disconnected it. You are getting close.

STEP 6 GATHER UP ALL YOUR TOOLS AND PUT THEM BACK IN YOUR BAG. Gather up everything that you brought aboard. Everything. You want to be ready to make a quick exit.

#### STEP 7 NOW OPEN THE SALT-WATER INTAKE VALVE WITH YOUR PIPE WRENCH

Open the valve all the way with pipe wrench. Water will begin rushing in This is the moment you have been waiting for. Put your pipe wrench on the valve stem and open the valve.


Salt water should begin spraying all over the place. Keep turning the valve stem until the valve is fully wide open. The ship has now hit the fan. Then lean on the pipe wrench and push it as hard as you can. Try to break the valve while it is locked wide open. We give bonus points for this. We want to jam that valve so tight that no one will be able to close it before the boat sinks.

Please note: This is the 'high pucker factor' part of the action. Don't be surprised at this point if your arse, in and of its own volition, bites five kilos of metal right out of the scaffolding that you are sitting on. If so, we excuse you.

## STEP 8 BASH THE VALVE STEM WITH THE PIPE WRENCH.

Hit it *hard* with the pipe wrench to try to bend it out of 'true' and further lock the valve wide open. Do whatever you can to further jam the valve in a wide-open position. While you are doing this, water will be flying all over the place and the engine room will be flooding right in front of you. Stay calm if you can—it *is* possible—and *just do it.* 

The ship is now sinking. We advise you to spend a few extra minutes to cut and break things. You should now take your boltcutters and cut all the injection nozzles to the diesel engines. We want salt water in the engine heads and cylinders. They tend not to run very well when they are filled with sea water. The metal also oxidizes quickly. Then take a mallet and smash all the gauges that you see. Go ahead and cut any pipes and hydraulic lines that you can. You may find

here are many understandings of what is considered to be violence. If we begin to ask ourselves if the destruction of inanimate objects is violence, we should also ask a couple of other questions to help obtain the context for our answer. For example, if a person steals money is it violent? If the money stolen is from a savings and loan and it happens to be the only money a family had to feed their children, and the children are now hungry, would it be considered violent? The children have definitely suffered, yet none of the bankers in the savings and loan scandals where ever charged with a violent crime. But someone who destroys property is always charged with a violent crime, even when no person has been hurt or even threatened. Is this a double standard? Indeed it is. A demolition team is not charged with a violent crime if they destroy a building, yet it is considered violent if someone destroys a building without permission. How can an act that does not threaten or destroy life be considered violent in one instance and not another? The answer is obvious - economics. If economics are destroyed at the same time property is destroyed the judicial system considers it to be a violent act. There is the paradox. A bulldozer can destroy and most people think nothing of it, but if you destroy a bulldozer it is considered violent and subversive.

If they discover their ship in the midst of sinking, they will try to board it and try to pump it out. We use the locks and tear gas to buy as much time as possible. There is a certain point when a ship gets so full of water that it hits a critical mass and cannot be rescued. The tear gas and locks help us to buy time to get the ship to that point.

Please note again: It is a serious crime to travel on air flights with tear gas. Do not do it. Also, the locks must have a long locking loop on them. These doors are made of thick metal and the locking arm will have to travel through thick metal before it can catch.

#### STEP 12 DITCH THE TOOLS OVERBOARD.

Ease them into the water with a rope on the bag. Do not throw them in because someone could hear the splash of a thirty-kilo bag hitting the water.

#### STEP 13 G.T.F.O. GET THE FUCK OUT !!!!!!!

You have two basic choices in exfiltration here. Either go underground immediately at a safe house, or leave the country as quickly as possible.

yourself with extraordinary adrenalized energy and strength at this moment. If so, cutting, smashing, and breaking things can be the *perfect* way to work it off. We have found this 'bashing' period to be a time of great, albeit somewhat frantic, fun. Please enjoy this 'sinking feeling.'

#### STEP 9 TAKE EVERYTHING YOU BROUGHT WITH YOU OUT OF THE ENGINE ROOM.

#### Leave no material evidence

#### STEP 10 IF YOU HAVE A TEAR-GAS CANISTER, JUST BEFORE YOU STEP OUT OF THE ENGINE ROOM DOOR, OPEN THE CANISTER AND SET IT UP HIGH SOMEPLACE.

Do not throw the tear gas canister into the incoming salt water. The salt water will considerably reduce the effects of the teargas. Just trigger the canister and set it near the door. Needless to say, you should shut your eyes and hold your breath while you do this. Or put on a gas mask. Then quickly shut the engine room door.

If you cannot obtain teargas, try using some other nauscating, but non-poisonous substance. There are numerous recipes for such mixtures in other books.

#### STEP 11 PUT A HEAVY-DUTY, LONG-HANDLED LOCK ON BOTH THE ENGINE ROOM AND THE MAIN ENTRANCE DOOR.

We may have broken their locks while entering their ship, so we feel it is only proper that we should replace their damaged property. We're not scoundrels. We also feel it to be rather improbable that *their* keys would fit *our* locks. It has been our experience that it is best to leave as quickly as possible. It may take twelve hours for them to figure out that someone has sabotaged them. In the meantime, you can be long gone.

As soon as you are safely away from the ship, we advise you to take off and completely dispose of everything that you have worn onto the ship. This includes your shoes. Then wash yourself off. Remove all of the disel fuel and salt water that you may have gotten on yourself. Then put on a clean change of clothes. We think that you should now 'dress for success'. We would not want anyone to get the wrong impression about us ecoteurs as we are leaving their country.

#### GENERAL NOTE:

If you have not used explosives or violence against people (both of which I am totally opposed to) then generally, it will be difficult for the site country to extradite you. But they may try. Each case is different. In the past, countries have not even tried because of the potential embarrassment of a media trial. They want to keep their eco-crimes quiet. It is your personal choice whether you want to further embarrass the country where you did your scuttling by participating in such a trial. Some scuttlers have turned themselves in after the fact. Others have not. I personally want you to live on to become the 'serial sinker'. I well understand that it is the healthy reaction of any wild animal not to knowingly enter a cage. And who wants to bother with a international legal system when their laws don't protect ecosystems anyhow? But of course, it is your choice.

## **Priest: Some stealing is OK**

LONDON (AP) - Despite what the Bible says about stealing, a Church of England priest suggested Saturday that it was no sin to shoplift - as long as the victim is a big supermarket. "Jesus said 'Love your neigh-

bor,' he didn't say 'Love Marks and Spencers,' " the Rev. John Papworth said, referring to the big British retailer.

Papworth drew a distinction between stealing from individuals or small merchants which he says is wrong - and stealing from giant retailing corporations. Those, he says, have run little stores out of business and harmed local communities.

Papworth, who works part time at St. Mark's Church in the St. John's Wood area of northwest London, went against church teaching, ac-cording to the Venerable Pete

Broadbent, a ranking regional official of the Church of England.

Please hear our request, a request that comes from our ancestral right by virtue of being born on our territory: Halt your oil project on U'wa ancestral land.

The U'wa people need your sign of respect.

#### U'WA HOMELAND ESCAPES OIL EXPLORATION

LOS ANGELES, California, May 27, 1998 (ENS) - An official of Occidental Petroleum (Oxy) has confirmed that the company and partner British Petroleum (BP) will not explore for oil on lands claimed by the U'wa indigenous people of Colombia. The U'wa reservation is in the El Cocuy National Park close to the Venzuelan border.

The 5,000 U'wa have threatened to commit mass suicide by jumping off a tall cliff if oil exploration is allowed to take place on reservation lands or onds they claim as part of their traditional homeland. The tribe has a cultural tradition of mass suicide, but an Occidental Petroleum spokesperson says the threat had nothing to do with contract renegotiations now underway in Colombia.

The U'wa, a highly traditional and unacculturated people, believe that oil is the blood of the earth and that to extract it is equivalent to committing matricide.

Los Angeles activists staged a dramatic protest in support of U'wa demands in April at the Oxy corporate headquarters building on Wilshire Boulevard where they inserted an enormous oil pipeline into the lobby and splashed itwith fake blood.

Those 185,000 kilos of gold and 16 million kilos of silver must be considered as the first of several friendly loans granted by America for Europe's development. The contrary would presuppose war crimes, which would mean not only demanding immediate return, but also compensation for damages.

I prefer to believe in the least offensive hypothesis. Such fabulous capital exports were nothing short of the beginning of a Marshalltezuma Plan to guarantee the reconstruction of a barbarian Europe, ruined by deplorable wars against the Muslim foe. For this reason, as we approach the Fifth Centennial of the Loan, we must ask ourselves:

as if my senses are being assaulted.


All of this, I believe in. I've felt it, tasted it, seen, smelled and heard it. Simply put, I believe in reality.



## Manifesto of the Phantom Tree Planters

Planting trees opens our hearts to Nature's wisdom. Nurturing them gives exposure to life's vulnerability and teaches how to build ecological and human community.

We plant trees not for ourselves, but for those who will follow. Life gives unto life, and by dancing to its rhythms we can enjoy with clear conscience what has been handed down from the past.

Many people have never planted a tree because they think they do not own land. This is mistaken. We are all children of the Earth. We share equally in the valleys, hills, rivers and seas. Let us no longer be deceived otherwise!

Phantom Treeplanters have no formal organisation, no joining fee, and only the Earth holds its membership list throughout time. To belong, simply plant a tree without expectation of material gain, help care for existing ones, or hold in your heart what they mean.

With due sensitivity, plant trees on any land and in any place where they have a chance of surviving. Do not be put off by feeling you always have to get permission. Nature saws without asking. You are part of nature. Reconstituting the world is a duty and a right which extends beyond legal concepts of land ownership.

You can buy suitable native species from nurseries. But better still, root a length of wilow in a bottle or collect and sow seed from original local sources. Is it too long to wait for an acorn to grow? Maybe you do not need to live so fast that only instant results satisfy. Try starting some trees in a deep pot on the window ledge or dig up a stretch of lawn. Never mind if you cannot foresee where to transplant the seedlings. Grow them first. Life will work out the rest, when the time is right.

Do not worry too much about losses. Accept these as part of the process. Take heart that other treeplanters are also at work. What matters is not individual success or failure, but the overall process we share in.

Planting trees is about making love with the Earth. Phantom planting recreates wildness. So let us live and love wildly. Let us not be afraid to grow and change. Let us celebrate - life itself.

t (Staff) – A 42-year-old Kootenay man was killed Saturday in a logging related incident north of Winlaw.


Police said Norman Eugene Severeid of New Denver and Kaslo was working in a cut block 14 kilometers up the Lemon Creek Road. The site was being helicopter logged for Slocan Forest Products by Cedar Haven Contracting who had contracted the tree falling out to a local contractor Sterling Falling. According to police Severeid was working the cut block with two other loggers and had started the day at 7 a.m. At about 8:30 a.m. the two fallers had noticed that Severeid was missing.

RCMP said a search by his coworkers located Severeid lying on the ground with his chainsaw still running and a 10-inch diameter by 70-foot-long tree lying on top of him. Severeid was removed after attempts on site to revive him failed.

Nelson RCMP, the local coroner and the Workers' Compensation Board are continuing their investigation this week.




## **Tree protesters sprayed**

Humboldt Co. sheriff's deputies gently swabbing pepper spray into the eyes of a vicious environmental protester.

The FBI has begun an investigation into possible civil rights violations by the Humboldt County sheriff's deputies for their application of pepper spray to the eyes of protesters occupying the office of Republican Representative Frank Riggs to protest the logging in Headwaters Forest.

We intend to do as thorough an investigation of this incident as we did in the Judy Bari/Darryl Cherney/EarthFirst! bombing case," offered George Grotz, a spokesperson from the San Francisco office of the FBI.

Riggs, breathless from a fifteen minute soliloquy in defense of the deputies` actions on the floor on congress, commented that law enforcement officers 'had no choice" but to swab pepper spray directly into the protesters' eyes and spray at close range. "Our furniture was at risk," he pointed out, "and eco-terrorists have no regard for the law or the sanctity of federal property.

Nancy Delaney, attorney representing the sheriff's department, argued that the sheriff deputies' actions were justified. "We believe the facts will demonstrate the officers were extremely patient and there is no softer or safer swab than Q-tips Cotton Swabs.

A spokesperson from Chesebrough Ponds Inc., which manufactures the cotton swabs, confirmed that their swabs were the safest and gentlest on the market

Mark Harris, an attorney for the protesters, had no comment about the actual quality of the allegedly 100% cotton Q-tip swabs.

"The victims in this incident were my employees," said Riggs. "And, of course my office furniture."





The man slapped the pie down on top of Hurwitz's head as the Maxxam executive was leaving Scotia Inn after a luncheon meeting with timber industry and business executives and local govern-

Hurwitz was angry, Campbell said, but made a quick recovery. "He said, Too bad it was peach; I like blackberry,' " Campbell

said. "We didn't know anything

about this," Cherney said. "It definitely wasn't an Earth First action.'

Darren Thurston and David Barbarash are Canadian activists who have spent time in prison for illegal direct action taken on behalf of animals suffering institutionalized abuse. As a result of their history with the Animal Liberation Front, they have been the subjects of intense harassment by government agencies for the past 3 years.

During this time, they have undergone intense police scrutiny, buring this time, they have undergone intense poince scrutiny, including foot, vehicle and aerial surveillance; monitoring devices placed in both vehicles and homes; had thousands of email, fax and voice communications intercepted; and had vast amounts of files and property seized in raids. The Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) even surrepticiously seized my truck under false pretenses to place a bug.

The RCMP had named Darren and David as their prime targets in their investigation of four mail bombs sent to racists and a geneticist in 1995, and razor blade booby trap letters sent to 27 guide outfitters in 1995-96. The mail bombs were claimed by the Militant Direct Action Task Force and the razor blade letters by the Justice Dept.

The increasingly uphill battle just got a little steeper. But Darren and David are not your everyday activists - they are lifelong soldiers, they are tough, and they will march on and overcome whatever ordeal is That is just one of the many qualities that makes put before them. them special to those who know and love them and invaluable as advocates for the animals and the environment.

## 35 Year Sentence For ALF Activist

SALT LAKE CITY, UTAH--Joshua Ellerman, age 19, will start a 35 year long prison sentence on May 6, 1998 for the million dollar bombing of the Utah Fur Breeders Agricultural Co-op last March. Josh was charged with 16 different federal charges--which if convicted of them--could have resulted in a175 year prison sentence. Considering the detailed evidence against him, a plea bargain was determined to be the best option. Josh plead guilty to three of the 17 charges: using explosives to damage property used in interstate commerce, making a pipe bomb, and using a pipe bomb.

Josh's severe sentence directly resulted,

in part, from his refusal to testify against other ALF activists.

Recently, Josh's 21-year-old brother Colby started a two year prison sentence for his involvement in a mink raid.

Once we step out in any form of protest then the power of the state may fall upon us with unrelenting force. We are subject to arrest and imprisonment at any time, most of us, simply because we choose to be who we are because we want to live the lives we choose in spite of the plans others make for us, because we dare to be different or because our eyes are open to the realities of our likely future, wearing the yoke of capitalism around our necks like beasts of burden, not equal human beings, unless we throw off the weight on our back to stand in the sun in our rightful place. Look at the person beside you , across the way from you and then fully realize that individual may one day be arrested and so may you because you dare to be different, threatening to those who seek to control us, especially if your life is governed by the principles of anarchism or you believe in / have undertaken direct action against your oppressors. Getting arrested is no joke so without getting too paranoid, find out what to do in such a situation and also wise up about the police. I am often blunt to the point of pain so I do apologise if my words have made anybody uncomfortable but I think one sobering thought really needs to bring a wake-up
